





6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

1. NEET QUALIFICATION IS NECESSARY

Admissions without NEET Qualification is also possible, but at the risk of the student not being able to pursue PG in India. NEET Qualification is required to appear for NExT.

2. STUDY AT WHO RECOGNIZED UNIVERSITIES

Students are required to study only at the World Health Organization (WHO) recognized Universities. WHO recognition can be easily checked online at the World Director of Medical Schools website (www.WDOMS.org)

6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

3. STUDY AND INTERN AT THE SAME UNIVERSITY

Students should study MBBS for a minimum of 54 months following a rotational internship of 12 months.

4. REGISTER AS A PRACTITIONER

Foreign MBBS Graduates will have to register as a medical practitioner in the country they studied in before returning to India. This is taken care of by the University the student is studying in.

6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

5. CLINICAL PRACTICE IN INDIA BEFORE NEXT

Foreign MBBS Graduates will have to put in a year of clinical practice in India before they can appear for NExT - these rules are still being drafted for better clarity.

6. CLEAR NEXT ON COMPLETION OF MBBS

Be it from India or Abroad - all MBBS graduates will have to appear for the National Exit Test (NExT) in India to obtain their practicing license. NExT is also replacing NEET-PG and thus will be the PG Entrance Exam as well.




1. ENGLISH ONLY

WHO mandates all Education and Instruction to be in English for Universities admitting students under the 'foreign quota' - the quota reserved for students from other countries - even Indian Government Universities follow this rule strictly for foreign students.

- Does not collect Tuition and Hostel fees on behalf of the University
- Promises to provide support for the next 6 years of your education
- Does not sway you with marketing tactics like free NExT Coaching from the 2nd year itself!

RECOMMENDED STEPS TO PURSUE MBBS ABROAD

2. PICK OUT A COUNTRY THAT -

- Appeals to you remember where you do your
 MBBS from will not matter once you become a doctor
- Fits nicely within your budget its a 6 year commitment - choose wisely - do not stretch your budget just to accommodate a fancier country -MBBS is the dream - not the 'where from?'

3. PICK OUT A UNIVERSITY THAT -

- Is reputed, prestigious or boasts of a good ranking
- Fits within your budget MBBS Abroad decision should be based on your budget

RECOMMENDED STEPS TO PURSUE MBBS ABROAD

4. CALCULATE ALL COSTS

- It is just not tuition fees, there are other costs as well
- Understand whether hostel fees include Mess charges
- Mess can costs up to \$120/ month almost the same as India but should be considered in your budget






