CAT A

GOVERNMENT SEATS

Fees range from 50,000 to 5Lacs per annum.

CAT B

MANAGEMENT SEATS

All seats are allocated through Counselling only. Available only in Private Medical Colleges.

Fees range from 14lacs to 22lacs per annum.

CAT C

NRI SEATS

NRI Seats are available only in Private Medical Colleges through Counselling.

Fees begin from 30lacs+ per annum.

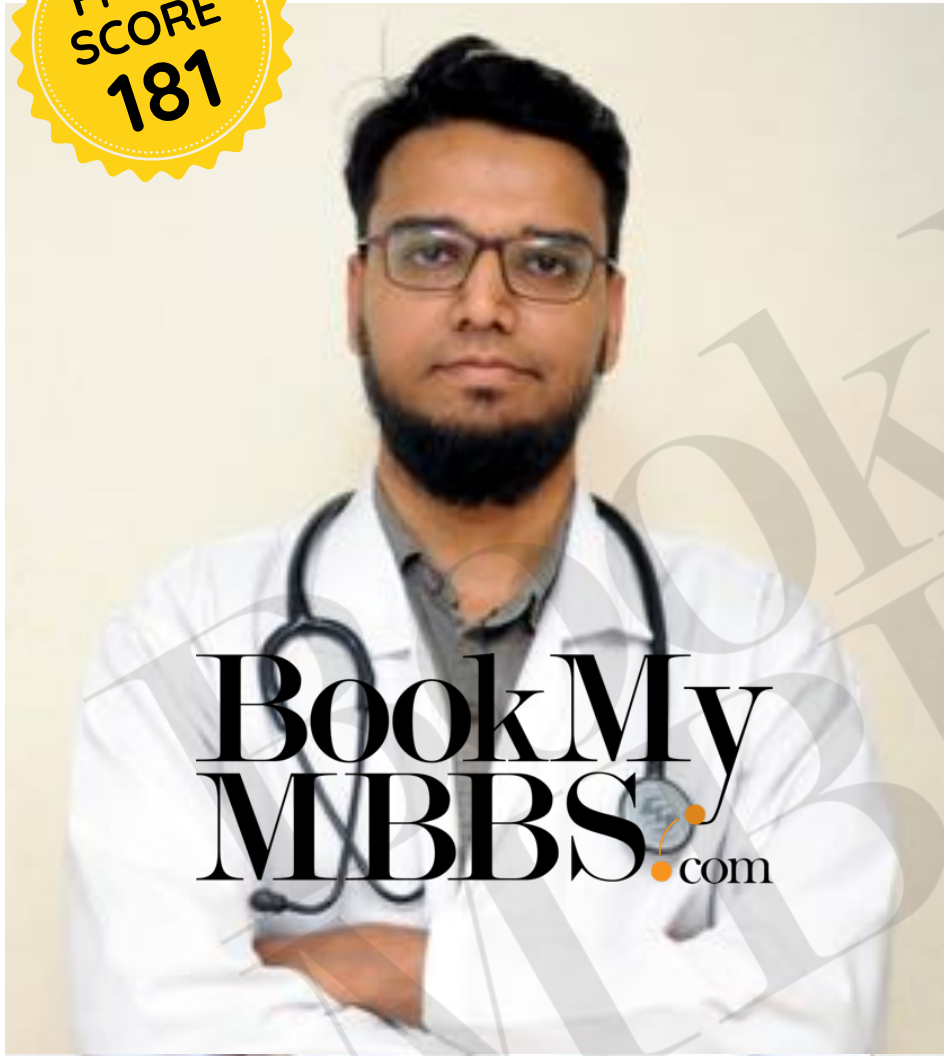

WHY STUDENTS GO FOR LONG-TERM NEET?

- Long-term NEET is the go-to option for a lot of students who do not secure enough marks
- Students believe that if they work and study harder **they will achieve drastic changes in their NEET scores** after studying for NEET for an entire year
- Long-term NEET is marketed as a sure-shot chance of securing a seat in India. Ramification of **losing an entire year** is not accounted for

- Students who either **did not qualify NEET or who secured more than 450 in NEET** with a commitment of spending an entire year in active education
- Students who do not think **the implication of wasting an entire year will matter** in the grander scheme of pursuing their MBBS dream
- Students who really want to be a Doctor but **can't afford the high tuition fees in private colleges** or even the affordability of MBBS Abroad

WHY YOU SHOULDN'T GO FOR LONG-TERM NEET?

- Long-term NEET does not help. It is unscientific, unproven and **has hardly delivered exceptional success stories**
- **Long-term NEET ends up eating up your entire year** - no student can commit to such endurance to change their fortune, **especially if your previous score was less than 400**
- Being a doctor is a long-drawn education - it is almost 8 years of UG and PG. **Wasting a year, just to try, does not make sense** when there are other options to pursue MBBS

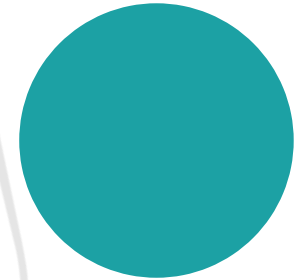
NMC

The National Medical Commission of India (NMC) is the governing body regulating all Medical Education in India and Abroad. It was formed in 2020 after the Medical Council of India (MCI) was abolished in 2019.



WHO

The World Health Organization (WHO) is a specialized agency of the United Nations (UN) that connects nations, partners and people to promote global health, medical support & common practices.



WDOMS

The World Directory of Medical Schools is a directory of all WHO recognized Medical Schools and in-turn by the entire world. This list is maintained by WFME and FAIMER under the supervision of WHO.

6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

1. NEET QUALIFICATION IS NECESSARY

Admissions without NEET Qualification is also possible, but at the risk of the student not being able to pursue PG in India. NEET Qualification is required to appear for NExT.

2. STUDY AT WHO RECOGNIZED UNIVERSITIES

Students are required to study only at the World Health Organization (WHO) recognized Universities. WHO recognition can be easily checked online at the World Director of Medical Schools website (www.WDOMS.org)

6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

3. STUDY AND INTERN AT THE SAME UNIVERSITY

Students should study MBBS for a minimum of 54 months following a rotational internship of 12 months.

4. REGISTER AS A PRACTITIONER

Foreign MBBS Graduates will have to register as a medical practitioner in the country they studied in before returning to India. This is taken care of by the University the student is studying in.

6 MAIN REGULATIONS FOR MBBS ABROAD AS PER NMC

5. CLINICAL PRACTICE IN INDIA BEFORE NExT

Foreign MBBS Graduates will have to put in a year of clinical practice in India before they can appear for NExT - these rules are still being drafted for better clarity.

6. CLEAR NExT ON COMPLETION OF MBBS

Be it from India or Abroad - all MBBS graduates will have to appear for the National Exit Test (NExT) in India to obtain their practicing license. NExT is also replacing NEET-PG and thus will be the PG Entrance Exam as well.

3. WORLD-CLASS, TOP-RANKED UNIVERSITIES

MBBS for Indian students is available in many top-ranked and prestigious universities that are Government aided. Admissions into foreign quotas give students the opportunity to study at Universities that are ranked much better than their Indian counterparts.

4. QUALITY IS DETERMINED BY THE STUDENT

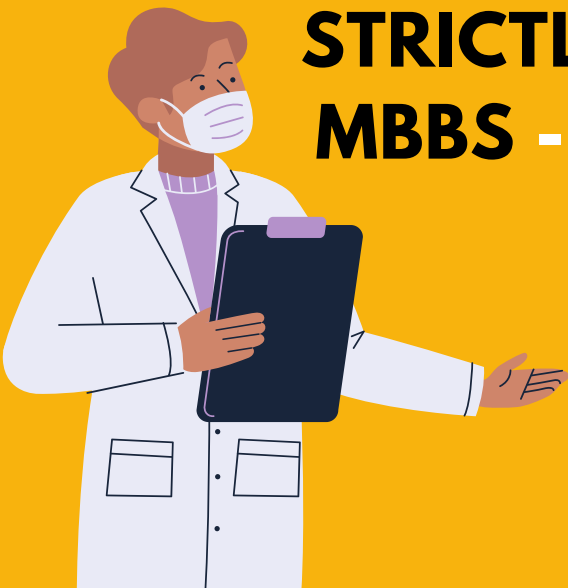

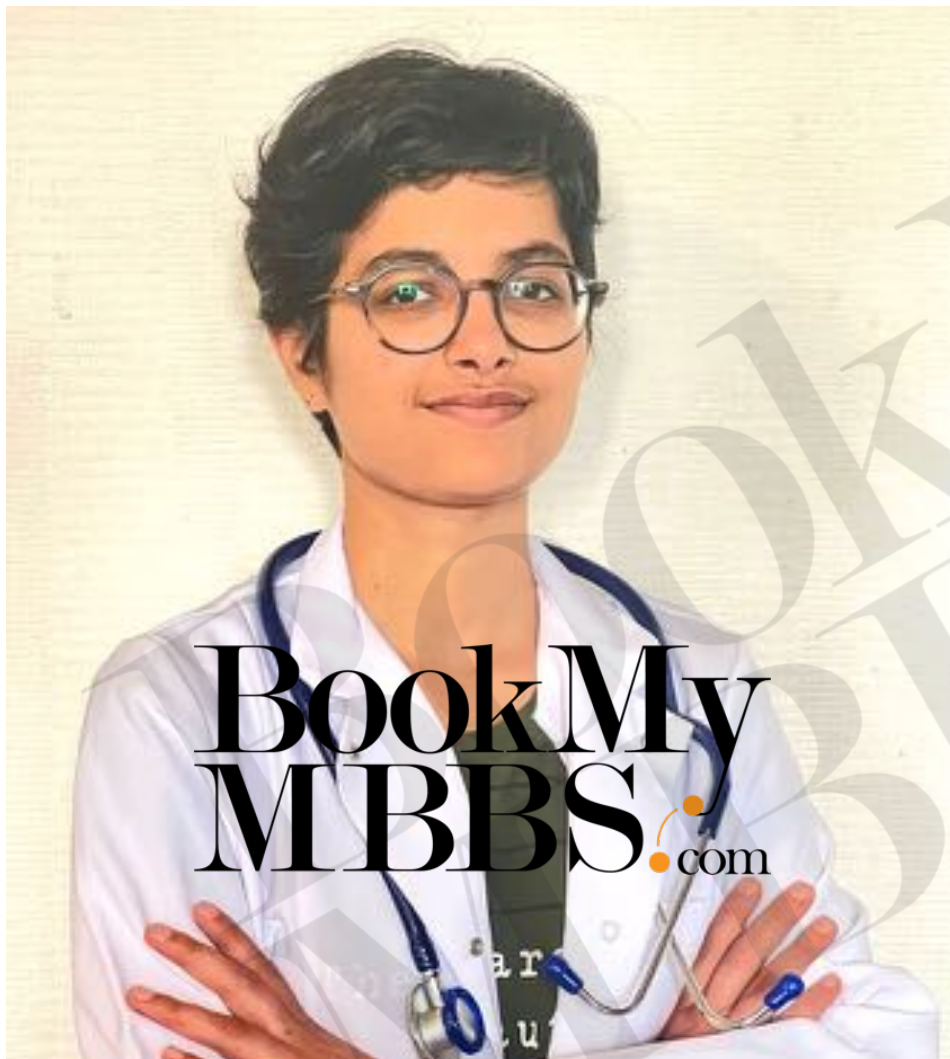

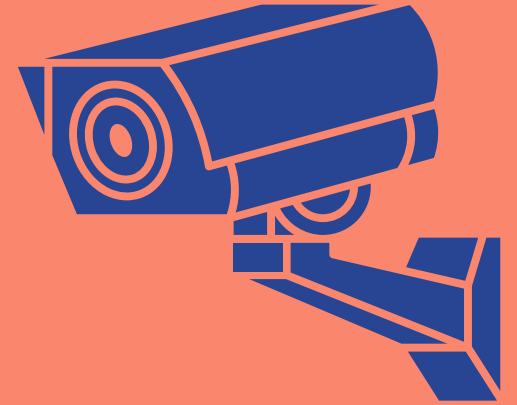
MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

1. ENGLISH ONLY

WHO mandates all Education and Instruction to be in English for Universities admitting students under the 'foreign quota' - the quota reserved for students from other countries - even Indian Government Universities follow this rule strictly for foreign students.

2. LOCAL LANGUAGE LESSONS

All foreign medical universities include the local language as part of the syllabus from the 1st year. Students need to learn the local language to be able to fulfil their medical rotations requirements that requires them to interact with the local patients, doctors & nurses.

1. SAFE & SECURE ENVIRONMENTS

Different countries rank differently while different universities assure varying levels of security - but in general, everyday living is safe, comfortable and highly secure and in most cases, much better and safer than India. RECOMMENDED STEPS TO PURSUE MBBS ABROAD

1. FIND A CONSULTANT WHO -

- Thinks for you and is honest with the information
- Shares all Costs transparently
- Converts the Dollar at the present market value
- Shows genuine concern and gives you time
- Does not push for select universities you don't want
- Does not collect Tuition and Hostel fees on behalf of the University
- Promises to provide support for the next 6 years of your education
- Does not sway you with marketing tactics like free NExT Coaching from the 2nd year itself!

RECOMMENDED STEPS TO PURSUE MBBS ABROAD

2. PICK OUT A COUNTRY THAT -

- Appeals to you - remember - where you do your MBBS from will not matter once you become a doctor
- Fits nicely within your budget - its a 6 year commitment - choose wisely - do not stretch your budget just to accommodate a fancier country - MBBS is the dream - not the 'where from?'

3. PICK OUT A UNIVERSITY THAT -

- Is reputed, prestigious or boasts of a good ranking
- Fits within your budget - MBBS Abroad decision should be based on your budget

RECOMMENDED STEPS TO PURSUE MBBS ABROAD

4. CALCULATE ALL COSTS

- It is just not tuition fees, there are other costs as well
- Understand whether hostel fees include Mess charges
- Mess can cost up to \$120/ month - almost the same as India but should be considered in your budget
- Yearly Visa Extensions and Health Insurance renewals are avoided in calculations - Make sure your consultant calculates it for you!

5. KNOW YOUR 10-YEAR PLAN

- Just not MBBS but have a clear picture of what your future plan is going to be. Talk to your consultant for guidance on your career as a Doctor.

HOW TO TAKE A DECISION?

Your MBBS Abroad Decision is a teamwork that should be achieved by the following 3 people in the team:

1. **The Parent picks out the budget** - MBBS Abroad should be a budget based decision
2. **The country should be chosen by the Student** - after all, they are the ones going there - incase a student is confused to select one, choose a country that has a stronger Indian Students support system
3. **The Consultant suggests the University** - a good consultant will always suggest universities that are good - if you know you have a good consultant - trust your consultant - else - do your research

ADMISSION TIMELINE

It takes 45-60 days of processing and documentation from the time a student enrolls till they get their travel visa - so prioritize accordingly

Admissions are done on 'First-Come-First-Reserved' basis - ensure you do not wait till the very end to get into your choice of university

If in doubt, all consultants provide the option of blocking seats in Universities against a refundable 'Block Payment' - use this option to avoid last minute disappointments

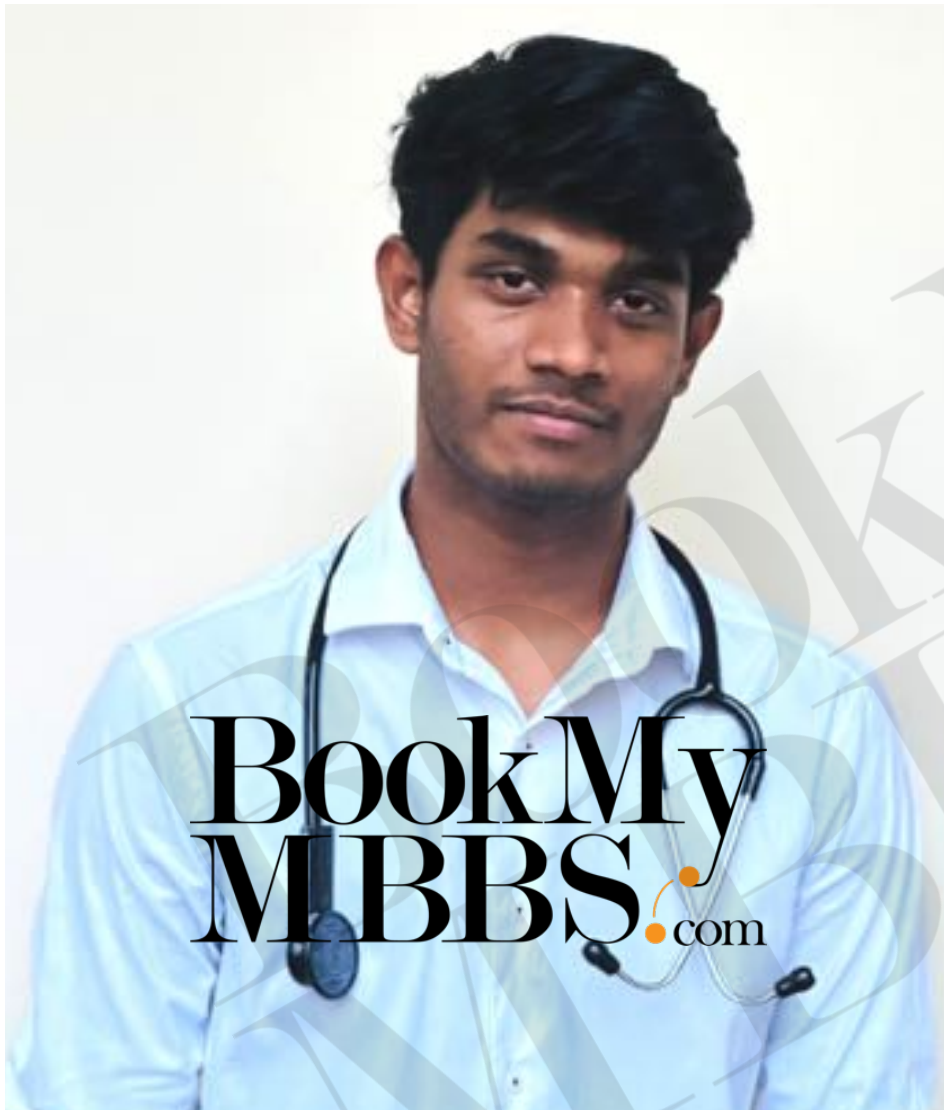
