

CAMP FORGE MODESTY POLICY



Modesty Statement:

Modesty is a biblical expectation for both men and women. At Camp Forge, we strive to please the Lord in all we do, including our attire. The application of the Bible's modesty principles varies from church to church, and Camp Forge desires to leave that right in the hands of each pastor and ministry. It is also necessary to set a clear and biblical baseline that churches can follow. Although these guidelines will apply to all churches at camp, we encourage every worker to focus on the people within their group.

Guidelines:

- General Camp Attire (*free time, activities, morning services*)
 - All clothing must fit appropriately. It should not be tight or revealing. Skirts and shorts must come to the top of the knee or below.
 - All clothing must be in accordance with Christian values. No worldly or sexual references or innuendos.

- Swim Attire
 - All Campers must be fully covered to and from swimming areas.
 - All campers must wear modest shorts and dark-colored t-shirts.

- Evening Service Attire
 - Campers are encouraged to dress up during the evening services.
 - Blouses and button-up shirts are encouraged. No T-shirts should be worn.

- Modesty Enforcement
 - Each church is solely responsible for the enforcement of modesty within its own group.
 - We strongly discourage any youth workers from becoming an enforcer for other groups.
