ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation have partnered to support 2024 Poetry Out Loud, a FREE national arts education program that encourages the study of great poetry by offering free educational materials and a dynamic competition for high school students across the country. This program helps students master public speaking skills, build self-confidence, and learn about literary history and contemporary life.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

In order to compete, schools and organizations must register with their state agency. All materials and resources are provided free of charge. Competitions – which can be conducted virtually or in-person – will begin in fall at the school or local level to identify representatives for the regional and state finals.

Each winner at the state level will receive:

- A \$200 cash prize
- A \$500 cash stipend for their representing school or organization to purchase poetry materials
- An opportunity to compete for the title of National Champion in Washington, D.C.
