Pouilly-Fuissé 1er Cru "Hommage à Léonard Chandon"

A ripe, spicy and more floral suffused nose is beautifully layered and quite elegant. By contrast, the palate impression of the dense, powerful and muscular larger-scaled flavors is overtly robust while delivering outstanding length on the equally focused, compact and built-to-age finish. Here too at least some patience is strongly advised.

Pouilly-Fuissé 1er Cru

A slightly riper if otherwise similar nose precedes finer if not denser flavors that coat the palate in sappy dry extract that imparts a seductive mouthfeel to the bone-dry, youthfully austere and compact finale that is noticeably more tightly wound. In contrast to the straight Pouilly-Fuissé, this is going to require at least a few years of patience and should repay 5 to 8 years of cellaring.

Whiffs of petrol, exotic fruit and essence of pear are trimmed in just enough wood to bother pointing out. The sleek, delicious and rounded medium weight flavors possess good mid-palate density while terminating in a clean, very dry and focused finale. This is lovely and a wine that should reward a few years of cellaring.
