90 – 94: *Outstanding*

Pouilly-Fuissé 'POUILLY' 1er Cru 2021 *Hommage à Léonard Chandon*

This is aromatically quite similar to the regular "Pouilly" cuvée except that the wood treatment is more apparent; indeed the word generous is apt. The rich and impressively dense broad-shouldered flavors brim with sappy dry extract that imparts a lavish texture to the bone-dry, painfully intense and massively long finale. This will also need time to digest its wood but it's potentially stellar.

92 – 94 | "SWEET SPOT"

Pouilly-Fuissé 'POUILLY' 1er Cru 2021

Here too there is ample petrol character to the ripe and fresh aromas of citrus confit, spice and subtle oak influence. The succulent but almost painfully intense medium-bodied flavors possess a highly attractive mouthfeel before terminating in a moderately austere and more tightly wound finale. This is excellent but note well that at least some patience will be necessary.

91 – 94 | "SWEET SPOT"

Pouilly-Fuissé 2021

Discreet wood sets off the ripe and fresh aromas of petrol, citrus, pear and acacia blossom. There is good richness and volume to the full-bodied flavors that display excellent length on the balanced finale that is supported by lemon-tinged acidity. Good stuff and worth considering.
