Mâcon-Bussières 'Mont Sard' 2021

Discreet wood sets off an attractively perfumed nose of acacia blossom, citrus compote and wet stone where the latter can be found on the appealingly textured medium weight flavors that exude evident minerality on the moderately austere, clean and equally chiseled finish. This is excellent for its level and recommended plus it will repay a few years of keeping if desired.

Mâcon-Milly-Lamartine 'Montagne de Cra' 2021

A more floral-inflected nose is comprised by notes of mineral reduction, lemongrass and Granny Smith apple nuances. The almost painfully intense middleweight flavors possess a wonderfully refreshing quality on the chiseled, youthfully austere and solidly persistent finish. This could use a bit more depth, but it is already inviting.

Bourgogne – Aligoté 'Les 17 rangs' 2021

Fresh and bright aromas of green apple, spice and just sliced citrus are trimmed in just a hint of wood. There is equally good intensity to the nicely detailed flavors that conclude in a dry, saline and lingering finish. This refreshing effort offers fine quality for the genre and is worth considering.

87 - "TOP VALUE"

Bourgogne – Pinot Noir 'Montagne de Cra' 2021

(vinified with 100% whole clusters). A very pinot nose reflects notes of cool and ultra-fresh red berries along with ample spice and floral wisps as the whole cluster vinification is evident. There is excellent precision to the refined, indeed almost delicate, flavors that conclude in a highly refreshing finish where a touch of bitter pit fruit character emerges. This is so delicious that it is almost gulpable and it would make a great choice for picnics or BBQs.
