### 2022 Mâcon-Milly-Lamartine 'Montagne de Cra'

A more elegant nose features notes of apple, pear and just sliced lemon rind. There is even better vibrancy to the utterly delicious and nicely detailed flavors that also terminate in a clean, dry and noticeably more complex finale. While this appealingly crisp effort could be enjoyed young as well, two to three years of keeping should be beneficial.

### 2022 Mâcon-Bussières 'Mont Sard'

A discreet application of wood sets off cool and pure aromas of green apple, lemon-lime and a touch of white peach. The rich, round and supple medium weight flavors possess a seductive texture and while the sneaky long finish is refreshing, it's not quite as dry or crisp as that of the Montagne de Cra.

### 2022 Bourgogne Aligoté 'Les 17 rangs'

A ripe and very aligoté-like nose offers up spicy notes of green apple and citrus confit. The rich and attractively vibrant middleweight flavors possess good verve on the nicely dry if not especially complex finale. This refreshing and easy-to-like effort should be enjoyable young.

### 2022 Bourgogne – Pinot Noir 'Montagne de Cra'

(vinified with 100% whole clusters). A decidedly ripe yet still fresh nose reflects notes of plum, spice, violet and a touch of rose petal. The juicy and seductive yet solidly punchy middleweight flavors conclude in a rustic but balanced and lingering finale. This is a very good Bourgogne and worth checking out, especially if you enjoy whole cluster pinot.
