## 2022 Saint-Véran 'Grand Bussières'

There is a whiff of exotic fruit to the white peach, poached pear, lychee and citrus-scented nose that is trimmed in just enough wood to notice. The very rich and quite generously proportioned middleweight flavors possess focused power that seems to build on the clean, dry and youthfully austere finale.

## 2022 Viré-Clessé 'Quintaine'

Here too there is a whiff of the exotic to the aromas of spiced pear, white and yellow peach and a similar level of wood influence. The medium weight flavors are rich to the point of opulence, indeed the mouthfeel is suave and sappy, yet there is acceptable punch that allows the finish to avoid a sense of heaviness. With that said, this isn't especially energetic and would best be drunk young.

## 2022 Bourgogne Chardonnay

Ripe and reasonably fresh aromas include those of apple, pear and citrus confit. There is fine mid-palate density to the rich, round and generously proportioned flavors that conclude in a sappy, mildly warm and rustic finale. To enjoy young.
