

I enjoy going out to eat at restaurants and spending time outside: skiing, sledding, walking, and running.






Hello, my name is Joe and I am excited to join the Trillium Director team.


**Life House Donation Drive**

This year's polar plunge had 624 participants and raised over \$165,000 for the Special Olympics of Minnesota!


