About Makewin Lodge Rentals



Facility Policies

While on ranch property, all renters are expected to adhere to the following policies:

- Groups are responsible to bring their own first aid kit and first aid person
- Smoking & vaping are only allowed in designated outdoor areas
- Alcohol is permitted upon approval of the rental coordinator. All permits, if required, must be shown upon approval and your will be required to pay a larger damage deposit.
- No drugs are allowed on Teen Time property including cannabis
- Arrival time and departure will be approved by our rental coordinator prior to your stay, extra fees may be required and will be discussed ahead of time

Facility Rules

We agree to and understand the following regulations

- 1. No smoking in any of the buildings. Please smoke in designated areas.
- 2. Alcohol is permitted with the permission from the rental coordinator and with the proper damage deposit and paperwork.
- 3. Please do not leave trash laying around outside.
- 4. Do not enter any rooms designated "Staff Only".
- 5. Do not cross the road to the barn without permission.
- 6. Please do not eat any food that is not yours. You are welcome to use the salt and pepper and condiments but any other food is not available.
- 7. Please do not take any food or drink into any of the dorm rooms.
- 8. Do not fix anything that gets broken. Inform the Host and he/she will take the necessary steps in fixing it.
- 9. Make sure that you have cleaned the lodge before you leave. If you do not clean up then you will be charged for someone to clean for you.
- 10. Put all garbage in green shack south of kitchen steps
