






WELCOME TO NIMALI TARANGIRE

DISCOVER A LAND OF *GIANTS*

It's easy to lose your heart at Nimali Tarangire. Although easily reached by road from Arusha, it's a world away from the everyday, with vast, larger-than-life landscapes filled with an abundance of life. From ancient, towering baobabs and huge herds of elephants often hundreds strong to more than 500 bird species and plains game aplenty, there's so many reasons to fall in love with this incredible place.





NIMALI TARANGIRE

LOCATION

Nimali Tarangire is located on its own private concession on the eastern border of Tarangire National Park, within easy driving distance of both Lake Manyara National Park and the Ngorongoro Crater. The camp overlooks a seasonal river that's dry for most of the year, surrounded by acacia trees and iconic baobabs, with private tented suites and intimate guest areas strung out along the riverbank, each with uninterrupted views of the wilderness.









NIMALI TARANGIRE

ACCOMMODATION

There are eight effortlessly elegant, tented suites at Nimali Tarangire. All suites have private decks overlooking the riverbed and ensuite bathrooms. Two cater specifically for families travelling together, with two bedrooms with ensuite bathrooms, a connecting lounge area and private plunge pool.

The décor is inspired by the landscapes around the camp, with lots of contemporary, organic design blended with artisanal crafts, natural materials and rich textures. Local fabrics and recycled glass add pops of colour to the soft grey undertones, creating a calm, relaxing environment that guests can unwind in and experience with all of their senses.

ACTIVITIES

Nimali Tarangire is located on its own concession, allowing for certain activities like night drives and walking safaris that are not offered at our camps inside the Serengeti National Park. This makes it the perfect complement to a stay in either Nimali Serengeti or Nimali Mara, or both. We also give guests the chance to visit one of our nearby Masai communities to learn more about this fascinating culture - something that it not logistically possible at our other camps. It is also possible to arrange a private day trip to nearby Manyara National Park and the Ngorongoro Crater, at an additional cost.



GETTING THERE

BY ROAD

Located only 2,5 hours by road from the city of Arusha, Nimali Tarangire is the perfect starting point for the northern safari circuit and combines easily with Nimali Serengeti and Nimali Mara. Its proximity to Arusha also makes it an ideal combination for a stay on the coast or more southerly Tanzanian safari destinations.

BY AIR it's accessible from:


- Kilimanjaro International Airport (3,5 hours' road transfer)
- Arusha Airport (2,5 hours' road transfer)
- Manyara Airstrip (1,5 hours' road transfer)
- Kuro Airstrip (3 hours' drive with a game drive and picnic lunch en-route)

*QUINTESSENTIAL*TANZANIA...


When the Maasai named this place, it was in honour of the vast landscapes that seemed to go on forever. They called it Seringit. Endless plains. Today, we know it as the Serengeti - where earth and sky collide in one of the most spectacular safari destinations in Africa. This is where you'll find Nimali Serengeti, at the centre of this legendary, 15,000km² national park, surrounded by one of the most prolific wildlife regions on the continent.





LOCATION

Enjoying a brand-new position close to Makoma Hill, in the heart of the central Serengeti, the reimagined Nimali Serengeti enjoys uninterrupted views out over plains dotted with kopjes on one of the Serengeti's most renowned great wildebeest migration routes, with the herds moving through from April to June and October to December each year. The game viewing here is outstanding all year round, with large herds of buffalo and elephant, an abundance of plains game and exceptional big cat sightings.









NIMALI SERENGETI

ACCOMMODATION

There are 14 tented suites at Nimali Serengeti, each enjoying panoramic views out over the surrounding landscapes of the central Serengeti. Two tents are connected by a shared walkway making them perfect for families. Each suite has its own private verandah and en-suite bathroom with bathtub and outdoor shower.

The camp's central lounge, dining area and pool deck offer more than enough space to relax in between activities, with a sunken fire pit the perfect place to toast the setting sun once the day's adventures are over. The décor takes its inspiration from the rich landscapes of the Serengeti, with a modern, contemporary style blending effortlessly with organic textures. Elements of antique brass add a warm, vintage feel.

ACTIVITIES

Nimali Serengeti's main activities are morning and afternoon game drives, exploring one of the most wildlife-rich regions of the park. This area is particularly well known for its predators, especially lion, cheetah and leopard, all of which are seen regularly. A hot-air balloon flight over the surrounding wilderness is also highly recommended.

GETTING THERE

BY ROAD

Although Nimali Serengeti is accessible by road from Arusha, it's an eight-hour drive and not recommended. Nimali Serengeti is four hours by road from the Ngorongoro Crater main gate and a four-hour game drive from its sister camp in the north, Nimali Mara. The Serengeti's Naabi Hill gate is approximately a two-hour drive from camp.

WELCOME TO NIMALI MARA

WHERE *REMOTE* TAKES ON NEW MEANING

In the extreme north of the Serengeti, close to the border with neighbouring Kenya, the Mara River slices through one of the most far-flung corners of Tanzania where rolling green hills dotted with acacia trees open into wide, grassy savannahs. This is where the great wildebeest migration meets its biggest challenge at its peak between July and October each year - crossing the Mara, a river with some of the highest concentrations of crocodiles in Africa. It's also where you'll find Nimali Mara - a camp literally on the edge of the action...

LOCATION

Nimali Mara is tucked away on the side of a low kopje overlooking gently rolling plains with views of distant hills beyond. This is one of the most remote areas of the northern Serengeti, making it exclusive and intimate, especially outside of the great migration, which has its peak between July and October each year. The game viewing is exceptional here all year round, with some of the highest concentrations of elephant, lion, leopard, cheetah, and hyena in the Serengeti.

The Mara River is just a 35-minute drive away from camp as it winds its way through the plains, en-route to Lake Victoria in the west. It's home to huge pods of hippo and some of the largest crocodiles in Africa, thanks to the countless wildebeest and zebra that fall prey to these gargantuan reptiles as the herds cross the river during the great migration.









ACCOMMODATION

Nimali Mara is a chameleon, blending effortlessly into its surroundings, making the most of the kopje's rock formations to create unique spaces where guests can relax and unwind in between activities. An infinity pool set within a natural cave offers the perfect place to cool down during the heat of the day.

The eight glass-fronted tented suites and two honeymoon or family suites completely immerse guests in their environment while affording exceptional views out over the Serengeti plains. Private decks are equipped with swing beds that make siesta time a treat. Even the en-suite bathrooms have views from their large, copper bathtubs with windows that open out directly onto wild Africa.

Nimali Mara's décor is a blend of contemporary and natural elements, using lots of organic influences to create texture and copper fittings to introduce a warm ambience.
