# Private Hāngi & Concert.

Sample Māori cuisine and enjoy a captivating private performance.

The experience begins at Whare Waka Café, where you meet your host. The hāngi feast will be unveiled and the cooking process explained, while you are enjoying a drink.

Your host will ensure that you are fully briefed on Māori protocol and then escort you to Te Whare Rūnanga. There are three challenges from warriors before entering Te Whare Rūnanga for a high energy cultural performance. Enjoy a highlight tour on the way back to Whare Waka Café, where the hāngi dinner is served and matched with a selection of New Zealand wines and beers.

## Q&A with the Curator

For larger groups we can organise a museum Q&A, where the group meet with the Curator of either Te Kōngahu Museum of Waitangi or Te Rau Aroha Museum of the Price of Citizenship for Q&A after the group has free time in the museum.

## Pōwhiri (Traditional Māori welcome)

A traditional pōwhiri includes a wero (challenge), karanga (welcome call) and haka pōwhiri (group welcome chant). Speeches, waiata (songs) and hongiri (pressing of noses) can also be incorporated. A Māori support person will brief visitors and accompany them throughout the pōwhiri. There will also be an opportunity for visitors to take photos and mix and mingle with the performers after the pōwhiri.

**Duration: 20 minutes**

## Private Cultural Performance

The performance starts with a spine-tingling wero (challenge) followed by a high-energy experience featuring waiata (songs), poi, stick games, Māori weaponry displays and the famous haka. Following the performance, visitors may take photos, ask questions, and interact with members of the resident performing arts group Te Pito Whenua.

**Duration: 30 minutes**

# Workshops.

## Wood Carving Workshop

Meet and kōrero with our kaiwhakairo (carver) to learn the art of carving and create your own special piece to take home. MDF block, paint and chisels are provided.

# Terms and Conditions.

Please take time to read the following:

## Venue Hire Rates

Venue hire rates are supplied upon application and are dependent on specific requirements of the chosen location and group size. Gear hire rates are fixed and supplied on request.

## Booking Confirmation

To confirm a booking, please complete an application and send back to Waitangi Limited who will prepare an invoice for 25% deposit of your event quote. Booking will be deemed confirmed upon payment of this invoice.

## Payment Terms

The remaining balance will be due 7 days prior to your event date, payable on invoice. Any additional costs will be invoiced following the function/event date or can be paid on the day with a credit card.

All invoices issued will be made payable to Waitangi Limited. Payment may be made by online via direct credit or credit card using your Booking ID as a reference. Please note that payment by credit card will incur 3% fee.

## Cancellation Policy

Waitangi Limited reserves the right to require payment of the full cost when bookings are cancelled within 30 days of the confirmed date.

Where food and any other third-party costs have been incurred and cannot be used/returned, the 25% deposit plus these costs will be payable to Waitangi Limited.

## COVID-19 Policy

Waitangi Treaty Grounds will be following the Government Guidelines in accordance with the current traffic light system. When date/s are confirmed Waitangi Treaty Grounds will ensure all Covid Level or Traffic Light regulations will be clearly communicated and adhered to.

If the COVID-19 Protection Framework traffic light system changes meaning the event cannot proceed as or as originally planned, clients have the right to postpone to another date within 12 months from the original booking. If the event is postponed to a date within six months of the original date, the original quoted price is applicable. If the event is moved to a date between 6-12 months from the original date, increased costs may apply. Deposits will be transferrable to the postponement date.

## Confirmation of Menus and Final Numbers

Confirmation is required no later than 7 days prior to the event; the final number of guests confirmed will constitute the minimum number charged for.

## General Terms and Conditions

1. All protocols, rules, bylaws, policies (including Health & Safety procedures) of Waitangi Limited must be strictly adhered to and all lawful instruction and/or requests made by Waitangi management and staff must be complied with.
2. The rights and enjoyment of other visitors to the museum and grounds must be acknowledged and respected at all times.
3. Waitangi Treaty Grounds is smoke free; this must be adhered to by all attendees within the Grounds. If a smoking area is required, security to enable smoking access outside of the Grounds will be required at an additional cost.
4. The provision of Waitangi Limited equipment/ personnel/resources will be identified and mutually agreed upon. There may be costs payable to the Waitangi Limited depending on the nature of the requirements.
5. Where there are any additional security requirements identified by either party, there may be costs payable to the Waitangi Limited. Details of additional security and costs will be covered as applicable under a separate schedule.
6. The building/area/gear hired shall be left in the original condition at the conclusion of the event and any costs incurred by the Waitangi Limited to restore equipment or facilities to the original condition will be charged to the applicant.
