Using locally sourced, sustainable biomass

Pictured above Hoar Cross Hall Hotel and Spa, Staffordshire Premium resort operator, Barons Eden, partnered with Reheat to undertake a pioneering 1MW sustainable biomass heating project, which is now a huge contributing factor in Hoar Cross Hall's decarbonisation objectives. Reheat designed and installed two state-of-the-art 500kW biomass boilers, replacing an oil based system, and also advised on wood fuel options.

As a result, Reheat has a long-term heat supply agreement with the hotel, sourcing sustainable wood chip from in and around the National Forest - most of which is delivered from less than 15 miles away. This allows Hoar Cross Hall to realise its ambition to become Net Zero, as well as support the local, rural economy.
