Description

As Eden becomes an increasingly popular cruise destination, the Eden Welcome Centre will be a new facility to greet up to 100,000 visiting cruise passengers each year. Designed by the award-winning architectural firm, Cox (who also designed the Bermagui Fishermen's Wharf) the building will improve not only the cruise visitor experience at the Eden Cruise Wharf but also improve the experience for the local community and other visitors to the Snug Cove.

Scope of Work

The Eden Welcome Centre will:

- have two floors with an approximate size of 1000 square metres
- a ground floor with capacity for visitors, an area for market stallholders and restroom amenities
- a first floor with office space for multi-agency staff with maritime responsibilities and other commercial uses.

The structure and cladding will be made from native hardwoods from the region as a tribute of the local timber industry and encompass features from Eden's rich maritime and fishing industry.
