In 2010, Kandice confronted cancer for the third time, Hodgkin's Lymphoma. This time, she pursued treatment at the renowned M.D. Anderson Hospital in Houston, TX. Amid her personal battles, Kandice and her high school friend Lindsey founded "Pretty Girls with Cancer™" shortly before Lindsey's unfortunate passing due to ovarian cancer.

Kandice's initiatives have been wide-ranging and impactful over the last ten years. Through "Pretty Girls with Cancer™," she collaborated with the "Be The Match™" program to locate donors for cancer patients. She also served as the Survivorship Chair for the American Cancer Society's "Relay For Life™" and initiated the "Totes of Love" project to provide comfort to cancer patients undergoing treatment at M.D. Anderson, Texas Children, and Methodist Hospitals. Additionally, she developed "Coinz 4 Kids With Cancer" currently in local school districts and the Mind, Body & Soul Therapeutic Retreat for cancer survivors and patients all focusing on mental health and self care.
