It is with great pleasure that we present to you, our 2016 Annual Report. Over the years our volunteers have worked tirelessly to provide comfort to youth in New York and this year the organization and our outreach have both grown tremendously because of your support. We've revised our mission, expanded our programs and pushed our efforts all the way as far as California.

After assessing the feedback and response to our Comfort Drops we decided to change our mission to enable us to provide our youth with additional tools for comfort. With the expansion of our mission we took the organization beyond the personalized comfort items for bedtime and tapped into providing more experiences that assist with mental health. In addition to changing our mission, we strengthened our partnerships in New York by working with Administrative Children Services (ACS) and we created a new Chapter in Los Angeles, CA.

It is because of the dedication and support of our loyal donors that Precious Dreams Foundation is able to touch the lives of underserved foster care and homeless children and reach new goals. Your commitment to improving the lives of our most vulnerable youth has made a real difference. At the close of 2016 we reached a total of 3,000 children in transition. IT ALL BEGAN WITH A COMFORT DROP

Guest Speaker: Connecting our youth with successful and inspirational speakers who tell relatable stories of overcoming adversity and sharing how they learned to self-comfort

Pillowcase Decorating: Designing a pillowcase full of positive reminders to help children focus on their dreams and explore happy thoughts.

Bag Delivery: A simple drop off of our customized Comfort Bags full of 4-5 brand new bedtime comfort items (i.e. pajamas, books, plush toys, journals, blankets and more)



Peace of Comfort (Yoga and Meditation): Youth learn to manage stress through healthy movement, meditation and relaxation.

Breathing techniques are shared for children to use who may struggle with impulsive behavior and/or distracting living environments.

Rest in Writing (Theraputic Writing Activities): Fun and creative writing prompts help our youth find comfort in the release of their thoughts and feelings. This program was inspired from the feedback of teens who received our journals from previous Comfort Drops.
