

## Going Deeper

Read John, chapter 10, verse 10. Think about why Jesus said He came. The end of Jesus' life on earth was our beginning. What does living your life to the full look like? How can we do that everyday? What are your 37 seconds?



Think about Mahoney and the block of wood. At first she didn't know what to use it for but then (1h 23m) she believed in herself (and the block of wood) and found her purpose. Read 2 Timothy, chapter 1: 6-7. What do you believe God has put in your life that you can fan the flames with, or make the most of?



In our lives we meet people who are special - family, friends, teachers and over the course of time, we find that they may not be around anymore. Read Psalm 34, verse 18. Before he dies, Mr Magorium tells Mahoney that after he is gone she must "turn the page, continue reading." (1h 9m). What can you do to make the next chapter count?

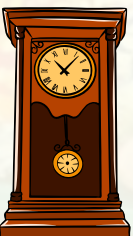
### Help your toys reach their potential
