Transient Student Admissions Applications submitted this past summer (24,994) showed an increase of almost 37 percent compared to summer 2022 (18,281). So far, during this fall term, applications (12,708) have grown almost 16 percent when compared to the same period in 2022 (10,972).

MICROSOFT ROLLS OUT NEW SEARCH FEATURES

"Microsoft recently announced two new search features: Bing Chat Enterprise for Faculty (BCEF) for Microsoft 365 A3 and A5 users and Search Progress, a new learning accelerator built into Teams Assignments. BCEF differs from regular Bing Chat in that there are commercial-level protections for faculty users. User and chat data stays within the organization generating it, and chat data is not saved. Microsoft has no access to it, and it is not used to train other models. BCEF will help faculty create content, customize learning, brainstorm, summarize..." (Source: Campus Technology)

The free app, Black Genius Academy, helps aspire Black tech learners by providing resources like personal guidance to help them locate and enroll in certificate and boot camp programs with supportive and successful Black tech leaders that guide them in navigating careers. They also have access to information on grant opportunities. Users on the app can listen to audio interviews with Black leaders in cybersecurity, software engineering, and user experience design fields. They also can get help working out a career plan." ■ EDUCAUSE 2023 STUDENTS AND TECH REPORT EMPHASIZES CHOICE & ACCESSIBILITY

"Educause recently released its "2023 Students and Technology Report: Flexibility, Choice, and Equity in the Student Experience. One of the key areas of this report is how accessibility impacts student education choices. They collected data from 1,953 students across 10 institutions. One of the key findings was that students' technology experiences relate to internet accessibility. Also, students with disabilities need more technology supports from their institutions, based on the type of disability.
