### Copying an existing layer

Rather than having to reimport the same data over and over again, or to prevent saving over a critical piece of work, you can copy an existing layer to your project using the **Copy Existing Layer** option in SKiN. The following instructions will give you a step-by-step guide on how to use the **Copy Existing Layer** function in SKiN.

### Before you begin

Before you start using SKiN you need to ensure you already have data imported into SKiN and saved in your project. Please refer to the following sections for help on importing data:



#### Copy an Existing Layer

To use the Copy Existing Layer tool, Open an existing project and then choose Add Data,
Copy Existing Layer.

### Add the Copied Layer

- A list of all the layers within the project will be displayed. The layers are grouped into two sections. My Points (Map Pin layers) and My Boundaries (Catchment, Hot-Spot and Territory layers). Select the layer that you want to copy by clicking on it. Your copied layer will then be added to your project. You can copy as many layers as you want to by clicking on the layer name and copying one layer at a time.
- When you have copied all the layers that you require, press the **Project back arrow** to return to the **Project Editor**.







### Return to the project

 All of the layers that you have copied will now be included within the My Data section of the Project Editor panel. The name of the copied layer will be displayed with the prefix 'Copy of' before the name of the layer that you have chosen to copy.
