

LOWER SEVERN (2005) INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD
LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1991
DRAINAGE RATES AND SPECIAL LEVIES
FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31st MARCH 2024

On the 8th February 2023 the above-named Board resolved as follows:

1. That the proportions of their expenditure to be raised by drainage rates in respect of agricultural land and agricultural buildings and by special levies on charging authorities are 8.46% and 91.54% respectively.
2. That the proportions between the local charging authorities of the amount to be raised by special levies are set out against the special levy for each charging authority.
3. To make the drainage rates and special levies set out below and the seal of the Board to be affixed to drainage rates levies:
