

# ASPECT END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR MICROSOFT® SQL SERVER® 2012 STANDARD

This Aspect End User License Agreement for Microsoft SQL Server 2012 Standard (**EULA**) provides the legal terms and conditions for the SQL Server 2012 Standard software (**software**). Microsoft Corporation or one of its affiliates (**Microsoft**) has licensed the software to Aspect Software, Inc. (**Aspect**). This EULA supersedes any electronic terms which may be contained within the software. If any of the terms contained within the software conflict with this EULA, this EULA will control.

The EULA applies to the number of licenses specified on your Order Document for the following Aspect Products, including any add-on licenses of the same Aspect Product(s): Aspect Unified IP®; Aspect Advanced List Management™ (ALM); Aspect Quality Management™ (AQM); Aspect Performance Management™ (APM); Aspect Workforce Management™ (WFM); and Aspect Via™. This EULA does not apply to: Aspect-proprietary software; other third party software licensed with the Aspect-proprietary software; or professional, educational, maintenance or support services provided by Aspect.

These license terms are an agreement between you and Aspect (or Aspect's local subsidiary where applicable). Please read them. They apply to the software, which includes the media on which you received it, if any. This EULA also applies to any Microsoft updates for the software that are provided to you by Aspect in accordance with Aspect's Support Policies (available at <a href="https://aspect.force.com/community/Home">https://aspect.force.com/community/Home</a>; requires log-in). The license key for the software is provided to Aspect by Microsoft. Aspect is an authorized distributor of this software. You will not receive a license key.

BY USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU ACCEPT THESE TERMS. IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THEM, DO NOT USE THE SOFTWARE. INSTEAD, RETURN IT TO ASPECT TO DETERMINE ITS RETURN POLICY.

# IF YOU COMPLY WITH THESE LICENSE TERMS, YOU HAVE THE RIGHTS BELOW FOR EACH SERVER YOU PROPERLY LICENSE.

#### 1. OVERVIEW.

- **1.1. Software**. The software includes server software, and additional software that may only be used with the server software directly, or indirectly through other additional software.
- **1.2.** License Model. The software is licensed based on a Core License Model the number of virtual cores in the server.

## 1.3. Licensing Terminology.

- **Instance**. You create an "instance" of the software by executing the software's setup or install procedure. You also create an instance of the software by duplicating an existing instance. References to the "software" in this agreement include "instances" of the software.
- Operating System Environment (OSE). An "operating system environment" or "OSE" is: (i) all or part of an operating system instance, or all or part of a virtual (or otherwise emulated) operating system instance which enables separate machine identity (primary computer name or similar unique identifier) or separate administrative rights; and (ii) instances of applications, if any, configured to run on the operating system instance or parts identified above. A virtual operating system environment is configured to run on a virtual (or otherwise emulated) hardware system.
- **Server**. A server is a physical hardware system capable of running server software. A hardware partition or blade is considered to be a separate physical hardware system.
- Hardware Thread. A hardware thread is either a physical core or a hyper-thread in a physical processor.
- **Virtual Core**. A virtual core is the unit of processing power in a virtual (or otherwise emulated) hardware system. A virtual core is the virtual representation of one or more hardware threads. Virtual OSEs use one or more virtual cores.

### 2. USE RIGHTS FOR CORE LICENSE MODEL.

**2.1. Licensing a Server**. Aspect will determine the required number of software licenses and assign those licenses to the server on which the software and the Aspect Product are installed.

- 2.2. Determining the Number of Licenses Required. Your license is based on the virtual OSEs within the server in which you run the server software. For each virtual OSE in which you run the server software, you need a number licenses equal to the number of virtual cores in the virtual OSE, subject to a minimum requirement of four licenses per virtual OSE. In addition, if any of these virtual cores is at any time mapped to more than one hardware thread, you need a license for each additional hardware thread mapped to that virtual core. Those licenses count toward the minimum requirement of four licenses per virtual OSE.
- **2.3.** Running Instances of the Server Software. For each virtual OSE which has been assigned the required number of licenses as provided in section 2.2, you have the right to run any number of instances of the software in that virtual OSE.
- **2.4.** No Client Access Licenses (CALs) Required for Access. Under this core license model, you do not need CALs for users or devices to access your instances of the server software.

### 3. ADDITIONAL LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND/OR USE RIGHTS.

- **3.1. Runtime-Restricted Use Software**. For selected Aspect Product Solutions, the software is "Runtime-Restricted Use" software; as such, it may only be used to run the Aspect Product Solution solely as part of the Aspect Product Solution. The software may not be used either (i) to develop any new software applications, (ii) in conjunction with any software applications, databases or tables other than those contained in the Aspect Product Solution, and/or (iii) as a standalone software application. The foregoing provision, however, does not prohibit you from using a tool to run queries or reports from existing tables.
- **3.2. Maximum Instances**. The software or your hardware may limit the number of instances of the server software that can run in virtual OSEs on the server.
- **3.3. Multiplexing**. Hardware or software you use to pool connections, reroute information, or reduce the number of devices or users that directly access or use the software (sometimes referred to as "multiplexing" or "pooling"), does not reduce the number of licenses of any type that you need.
- **3.4. No Separation of Server Software**. You may not separate the server software for use in more than one OSE under a single license, unless expressly permitted. This applies even if the OSEs are on the same physical hardware system.
- **3.5.** Included Microsoft Programs. The software includes other Microsoft programs listed at <a href="http://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=231864">http://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=231864</a>, which are licensed under the terms and conditions associated with them. You may only use these programs in conjunction with the software licensed here. If you do not accept the license terms associated with a program, you may not use that program.
- **4. BENCHMARK TESTING**. You must obtain Microsoft's prior written approval to disclose to a third party the results of any benchmark test of the software. However, this does not apply to the Microsoft .NET Framework (see below).
- **5. .NET FRAMEWORK SOFTWARE**. The software contains Microsoft .NET Framework software. This software is part of Windows and the license terms for Windows apply to your use of the .NET Framework software.
- **6. MICROSOFT .NET FRAMEWORK BENCHMARK TESTING**. The software includes one or more components of the .NET Framework (".NET Components"). You may conduct internal benchmark testing of those components. You may disclose the results of any benchmark test of those components, provided that you comply with the conditions set forth at go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=66406. Notwithstanding any other agreement you may have with Microsoft, if you disclose such benchmark test results, Microsoft shall have the right to disclose the results of benchmark tests it conducts of your products that compete with the applicable .NET Component, provided it complies with the same conditions set forth at go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=66406.
- 7. SCOPE OF LICENSE. The software is licensed, not sold. This agreement only gives you some rights to use the software. Aspect and Microsoft reserve all other rights. Unless applicable law gives you more rights despite this limitation, you may use the software only as expressly permitted in this agreement. In doing so, you must comply with any technical limitations in the software that only allow you to use it in certain ways. You may not:
  - work around any technical limitations in the software;
  - reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the software, except and only to the extent that applicable law expressly permits, despite this limitation;
  - make more copies of the software than specified in this agreement or allowed by applicable law, despite
    this limitation;
  - · publish the software, including any application programming interfaces included in the software, for others

- to copy;
- share or otherwise distribute documents, text or images created using the software Data Mapping Services features:
- rent, lease or lend the software;
- · use the software for commercial software hosting services; or
- remove, minimize, block or modify any logos, trademarks, copyright, digital watermarks, or other notices
  of Microsoft or its suppliers that are included in the software, including any content made available to you
  through the software.

Rights to access the software on any device do not give you any right to implement Microsoft patents or other Microsoft intellectual property in software or devices that access that device.

- **8. DOCUMENTATION**. Any person that has valid access to your computer or internal network may copy and use the documentation for your internal, reference purposes.
- 9. NOT FOR RESALE SOFTWARE. You may not sell software marked as "NFR" or "Not for Resale."
- **10. EXPORT RESTRICTIONS**. The software is subject to United States export laws and regulations. You must comply with all domestic and international export laws and regulations that apply to the software. These laws include restrictions on destinations, end users and end use. - 11. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This agreement, any separate terms for supplements and/or updates, and the separate agreement between you and Aspect governing the use of Aspect-proprietary products and third party products you procured from Aspect, are the entire agreement for the software.
- 12. LEGAL EFFECT. This agreement describes certain legal rights. You may have other rights under the laws of your state or country. You may also have rights with Aspect, from whom you acquired the software. This agreement does not change your rights under the laws of your state or country if the laws of your state or country do not permit it to do so.
- 13. NOT FAULT TOLERANT. THE SOFTWARE IS NOT FAULT TOLERANT. ASPECT HAS INDEPENDENTLY DETERMINED HOW TO USE THE SOFTWARE IN THE INTEGRATED SOFTWARE APPLICATION OR SUITE OF APPLICATIONS THAT IT IS LICENSING TO YOU, AND MICROSOFT HAS RELIED ON ASPECT TO CONDUCT SUFFICIENT TESTING TO DETERMINE THAT THE SOFTWARE IS SUITABLE FOR SUCH USE.
