(X, X, Y) hile the Chamber hosts an extensive events program throughout the year highlighted by some of the region's most significant Business events; the Business Awards and the Digital Marketing Day Out, we have a serious role to play making sure the voice of business is heard in relation to matters specifically affecting Port Macquarie. There are some key issues the Chamber will continue to lobby until a satisfactory outcome is achieved:

- The Port Macquarie Foreshore has long been a key concern. We continue to press our local State Representative and the Minister for Lands in order to seek a sustainable lona term outcome for our community.
- The sale of the poles and wires is an opportunity to address a key infrastructure need being the proposed orbital road linking Ocean Drive to the Airport. This is an investment that will be key to driving local economic efficiencies.

These are just two of the items of many issues that the Port Chamber has advocated on behalf of local business for. The Port Chamber keeps a regular dialogue with the Port Macquarie-Hastings Council, Member for Port Macquarie Leslie Williams MP and Dr David Gillespie as appropriate.

2014-15 showed a significant improvement on the previous financial year and was driven by both increased revenues and reduced expenses. Increases in revenue was driven primarily by the hosting of the Digital Marketing Day Out (DMDO), Memberships and Business Awards, and the Chambers first platinum sponsor was secured. The DMDO was well supported by not only the local community through ticket sales, but also through guest speakers who donated the services to ensure that event was hugely successful. The majority of savings were achieved through reduced employment expenses. Chamber Member services such as the monthly functions are run close to cost neutral.

Community groups benefit from the Chamber's work. The Chamber has proudly supported the Luminosity Youth Summit for the last three years. This year we also sponsored four young people to explore their potential through attendance at the Luminosity Youth Summit 2015.

Through generous donations from the Local Business Community, \$3,000 was raised at the Combined Networks Christmas Party for Galbaan House (Hastings Women's & Children's Refuge).
