According to the officer, the victims were not abused in any way by the arresting officers, and had the victims sustained any injuries at the scene of the arrest, they would have had to be taken directly to the hospital instead of being taken directly to Wyandotte County Jail, as was the case with the arrestees. Two of the subjects in the case refused to contact the Kansas City FBI office in order for them to be interviewed. Attempts to contact witnesses to the alleged police brutality were met with negative results on March 31, 1994, April 20, 1994 and April 25, 1994. Case is being closed by Kansas City based on the opinion of the SAC.
