This case is closed on the authority of the Special Agent in Charge, as it is not considered a serious or substantial matter. The victim lied to the interviewing Agent when he stated he had no prior arrest when in fact he has an extensive criminal history. The medical records from the emergency room where the victim was treated do not contain any notes that the victim indicated he had been hit in the head with a police flashlight. The notations from [redacted] who [redacted] visited on 12/27/94, state "Pt. probably wanting controlled substances." [redacted] the owner of the business where the arrest occurred, was present when the subject officers entered the building. [redacted] did not recall seeing the officers carrying a flashlight and he stated that lights were on inside the building at that time. The bathroom area where the victim was arrested contained many exposed nails, pipes and wood framing which could have caused the injury to the victim during an escape attempt or a struggle.

Facts of complaint  
On [redacted] DOB [redacted] was arrested by the KCKS Police Dept. for burglary, and is currently an inmate at the WYANDOTTE COUNTY JAIL. At the time of his arrest, the officer beat [redacted] with his flashlight, striking him on the head, shoulders, and back, causing a head injury and numerous bruises on his shoulders and back. After his arrest, [redacted] was taken to the KU Med Center, where the physician used 18 stitches for the head injury. [redacted] was then taken to the Wyandotte Co. Jail. Since the injury, [redacted] has experienced dizziness, double vision and headaches, and he has made numerous requests to see a doctor. The physician who removed the stitches at the jail indicated [redacted] injury could be a possible concussion and indicated if so, it would probably take several months for the symptoms to disappear. [redacted] has requested to see a physician, however, the guards have not contacted one for him. [redacted] stated that her son has admitted his involvement in the burglary, but does not feel he should have been beaten as severely. This incident has been reported to the Internal Affairs Division of the KCKS P.D..

Numerous partially driven nails are exposed on the walls and wood framing and there are exposed metal pipes. The ceiling consists of large flat metal objects (approximately 1'X 3' each). One of the ceiling pieces was pushed up and to one side.

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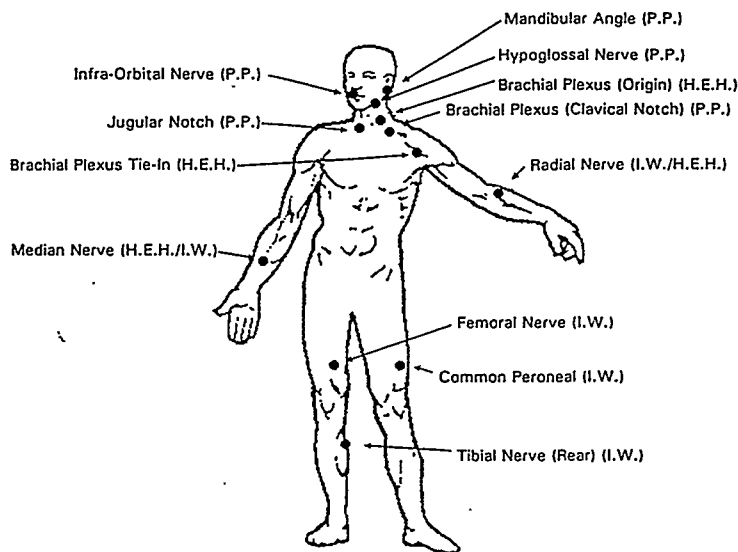

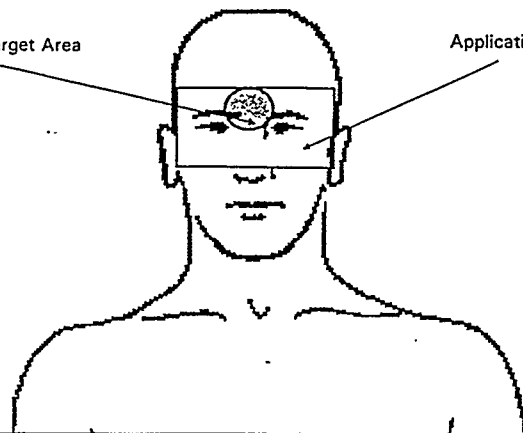
