INVESTIGATIONS INVOLVING OFFICERS OF KCKPD. THIS FILE HAS
THEREFORE BEEN CLOSED.

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This meeting was initiated at the request of the DOJ and is based upon Kansas City Division airtels to the Bureau dated 4/26/93 and 6/24/93 under the closed KCKPD file 44A-KC-71570. In brief, this meeting was to discuss the proactive approach in an effort to prosecute responsive and repetitive officers of the KCKPD for their utilization of excessive force under the color of law. DOJ Attorney [redacted] stated that the DOJ's objectives were to rid the KCKPD of excessive civil rights complaints of thefts, sexual abuse, etc., and to attempt to put a halt to the police corruption through the prosecution of targeted officers with a track record of utilizing excessive force.

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DOJ Attorney [redacted] advised that Paralegal [redacted] has been designated the "Garrity" reviewer that will review all of the subpoenaed Kansas City, Kansas complaint investigations conducted by the Internal Affairs Section of the police department to weed out compelled statements. In addition to [redacted] DOJ Attorney familiar with all aspects of the Garrity rule, [redacted] would also review [redacted] information. [redacted] noted that the strategy would be to identify between four to six officers out of approximately 18 that would be targeted for an aggressive investigative approach. In essence, the objective would be for the paralegal to review the complaints for any Internal Affairs investigation on a targeted officer for Garrity information, then forward those reports to Attorneys [redacted] and [redacted] to ascertain if further investigation merits prosecution. After DOJ's review, the cases would be forwarded to the Kansas City Division for intensive investigation. Investigative reports would in turn be furnished to the U.S. Attorney's Office, FBIHQ and directly to the DOJ to the attention of Attorneys [redacted]. Based upon the FBI's investigation, DOJ would consult with the U.S. Attorney's Office and empanel a special Grand Jury to prosecute anywhere between five and 10 cases for sealed indictments.

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USA RATHBUN, DOJ and SAC Kansas City concur with this investigative approach. It is noted, however, that some of the officers have in excess 13 excessive force complaints.

If the DOJ believes that all 13 complaints merit investigation, the investigation could entail the utilization of one agent for a three-month period. DOJ has identified approximately 18 police officers and the complaints as noted within referenced Kansas City airtels vary from four excessive force complaints to 18 excessive force complaints. Although Kansas City is committed to the pursuit of investigating these allegations, manpower/resources may be limited. In addition, FBIHQ should note that once this special is underway, it could take five to 10 agents approximately 12-18 months full-time to complete the investigation.

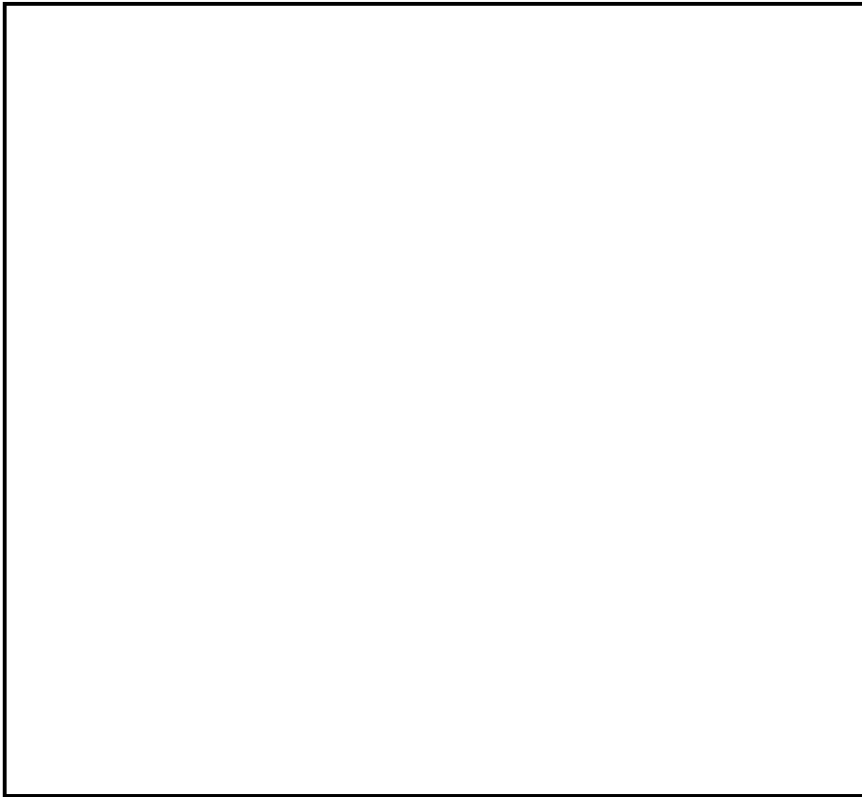

argument with his neighbor. The argument was in regard to a
puppy which belonged to [redacted] stated he went outside to
get the puppy and noticed that it was missing. One of [redacted]
neighbors was in his own yard and [redacted] asked the neighbor where
the dog was. An argument then ensued as [redacted] started accusing
his neighbor of taking the puppy. [redacted] stated he did not leave
the porch of his residence while the argument continued. After
[redacted] and his neighbor stopped arguing, [redacted] went back into his
residence.

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[REDACTED] stated approximately two hours later KANSAS CITY, KANSAS POLICE DEPARTMENT officers showed up at his residence. In the residence with [REDACTED] was [REDACTED]

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[REDACTED] approximately [REDACTED] years of age, and [REDACTED] approximately [REDACTED] years of age. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to go to the door and if the officers asked for him, [REDACTED] was to tell the officers he was not in the residence. [REDACTED] believed that the officers were coming to arrest him for a probation violation in regard to a recent simple assault charge.

[REDACTED] was trying to hide in the bedroom when [REDACTED] was talking to the police officers. [REDACTED] was trying to crawl under the bed, however, there was so much "junk" under the bed that he could not get under it. A few moments later [REDACTED] heard the officers kicking the door in as [REDACTED] was still attempting to get under the bed in one of the bedrooms. The three Kansas City, Kansas officers who entered the residence immediately saw [REDACTED] and went back to the bedroom. At that time, [REDACTED] was still trying to get under the bed. [REDACTED] stated the officers immediately started to beat his legs with their flashlights and billy clubs. One of the officers then lifted the bed which allowed the officers to beat [REDACTED] throughout his entire body with their flashlights and billy clubs. [REDACTED] stated that blood was everywhere from the officers beating him.

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During the struggle, one of the officers found a case with a knife in it. [REDACTED] stated the officers thought [REDACTED] was trying to get to the knife which he did not even know was under the bed. One of the officers took the knife out of the case. [REDACTED] later discovered he was charged with brandishing the knife at the three officers. [REDACTED] reiterated that the officer took the knife out of the case and that he did not, as he was not even aware the knife was under the bed.

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[REDACTED] additionally discovered he had been charged with two additional counts of aggravated battery for pointing a gun at two of his neighbors as a result of the previous argument concerning the puppy. The two neighbors included [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated the officers initially were looking for a handgun, however, did not find one in the residence of [REDACTED] so the officers accused [REDACTED] of attacking them with a knife.

Enclosed with this airtel is a listing of all KCKPD officers as well as the nature of complaint/allegation which was prepared by the DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ).

As noted above, Kansas City is utilizing the code name "TARNISHED STAR" to be used as a code name exclusively for civil rights investigations under color of law, utilizing force and/or violence to be initiated against several officers in which numerous complaints have been filed relative to the use of excessive force.
