	Engagement with schools? BBE Upper? Link with Abu Hanifa organisation?		
	Discussed Long, medium, and short term ideas. Targets not too hasty, around 2,000 extra fans per half-season aim.		
	Surprised to learn of reliance on matchday income. Eg: Leeds match = £400k from 7,000 fans.		
	Staff clearly of high quality, and dialogue in this way allows club to 'magpie' ideas from Rovers Trust. Meeting felt agreeable and our main message was to ask the club to experiment more and take risks re: fan engagement.		
	Consultation Event JM, OJ, and Peter Ridehalgh attended. Exceptionally positive response to Trust idea of Rovers Museum - to be included in Communication Strategy. Trust and Action Group in agreement that what has been done to the club can't be forgotten, but willing to move on in terms of relationship with club.
