We've a Story to Tell!

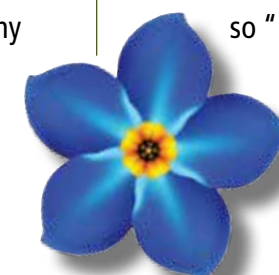
