At Waring, teachers write detailed narrative evaluations as opposed to assigning letter grades. Narrative evaluations fully reflect students' areas of strength and growth. Small Class Sizes With A Family Vibe

With 25-30 students in each grade level and an average class size of 10, the Waring community is very tight-knit. Teachers know all students by name and build long-lasting friendships/mentorships.

Unique Liberal Arts And Sciences Curriculum

French: Waring has a nationally-recognized French curriculum for both beginning and advanced learners, with award-winning faculty and an immersive teaching environment.

Art And Music: Art and music courses are required for all students. Private weekly 1:1 instrument/ vocal lessons are included in tuition and theater productions and musical ensembles perform on a regular basis.

STEM: Opportunities in robotics are offered at different levels, with teams previously winning World Championship Awards. The school offers strong computer programming courses and a robust science curriculum.

Speech & Debate: Students participate in Public Forum Debate as part of the National Speech and Debate Association, and debate at tournaments throughout the region, state and country.

International Travel And Study Tours Included In Tuition

Students participate in a Montreal Trip, French Exchange Program and Junior France Trip according to their grade level. Study abroad programs last around 3 weeks.

Waring also has a whole school camping trip each fall, giving the entire community a chance to welcome new students before classes begin.
