This program provides students with a self-paced, online university preparation course designed to educate students on the requirements of admission in the United States, Canada, and U.K. This online curriculum gives age-level and grade-level appropriate counseling \& guidance on the student's path to university admission

## Pre-Arrival Course Planning

Our academic advising team sets up course schedule planning meetings with each new international student before they arrive on campus.
These meetings are opportunities to discuss the US high school curriculum and address the common misconceptions that international students have about US high school course selection (such as graduation equirements, pre-requisites to take AP and honors courses, and how course planning and scheduling works at our school)

These meetings are also an opportunity, where possible, for our team to create a tentative course schedule for each international student to give them a vision of what kind of courses they will take in their first year.

## Pre-Requisite Accelerator

Ambitious new and returning students typically seek to enroll in advanced AP, Honors and College Dual Enrollment courses. Having these courses on a student's transcripts demonstrates their ability handle high-level courses to university admissions teams.
In many cases, to be accepted into these high-level courses, students need to take pre-requisite courses at the school. Therefore, to accelerate a student's
ability to be admitted to their desired courses, we offer the chance to take pre-requisite courses over the summer
