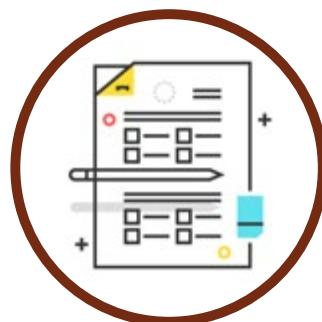

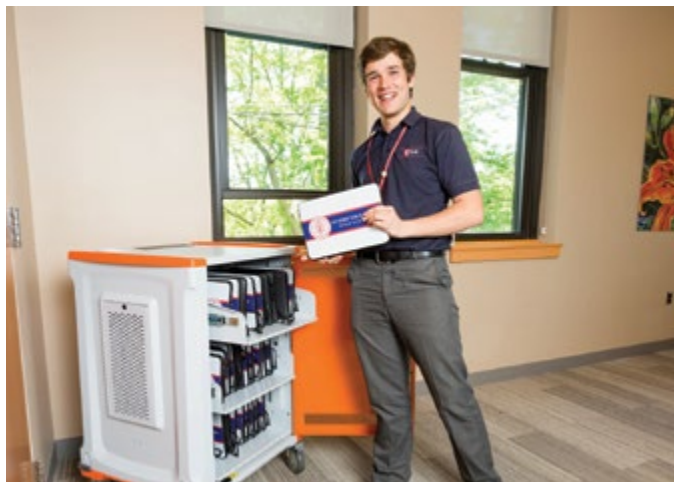

## Facilities + Academic Resources



### GENESIS RESEARCH PROGRAM

Through the school's unique GENESIS Program, students have the opportunity to pursue areas of study beyond the traditional classroom learning experience. Students conduct their own scientific studies alongside Project Mentors (including Saint John's teachers, college professors and/or professionals in the field of study) in fields including biology, chemistry, psychology and more. At the end of the year, students present their research to school staff.



### PROJECT LEAD THE WAY ENGINEERING PROGRAM

Saint John's has a robust engineering program through the internationally-renown *Project Lead the Way* program. The program includes 5 courses, covering Engineering Essentials, Civil Engineering and Architecture, Engineering Design and Development and more. Students who thrive in the program are eligible to receive college credit from the Rochester Institute of Technology.



### VIDEO BROADCASTING AND TV PROGRAM

Saint John's offers students a state-of-the-art Video Broadcasting and TV Studio, where students work together to create, produce and manage TV and radio shows. Students learn to work the equipment while reporting on school-wide announcements and developing their own content.

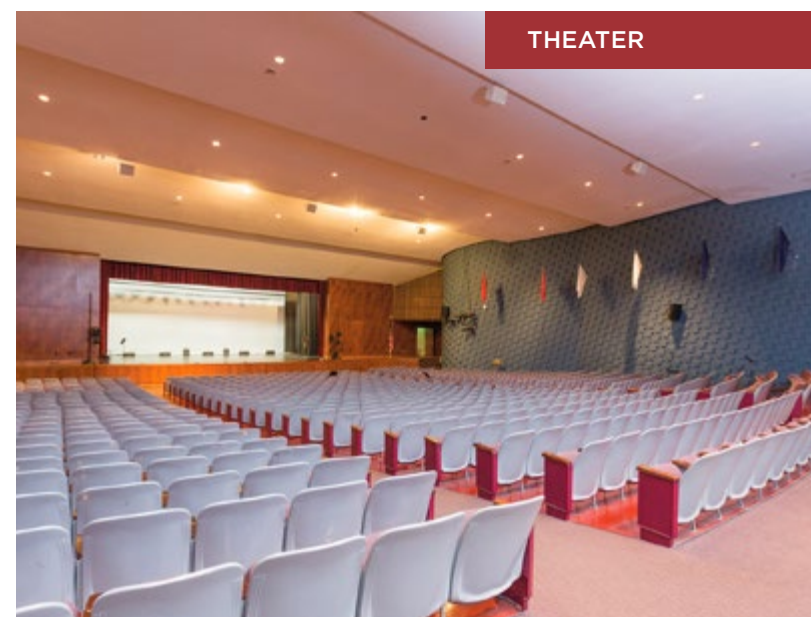

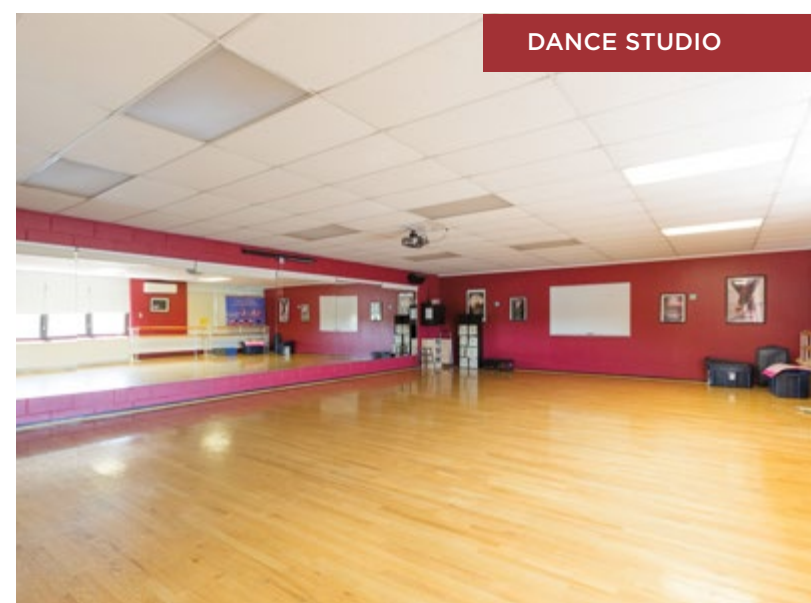

### University Advantage

Students engage with university admission professionals in one-on-one, small group and virtual planning sessions designed to help students understand how they can best leverage their American high school experience to become more compelling and competitive international university applicants.

Through the program, students are challenged to explore their academic and extracurricular interests, set rigorous personal goals, apply to summer programs, complete internships and craft a best-fit university application list.

### Amerigo Honors Track Program

The Amerigo Honors Track is an invitation-only program offered to top-performing international students who meet rigorous academic and English-proficiency standards during their studies. Students offered admission into the Amerigo Honors Track are required to participate fully in the program's curriculum, which was created to best prepare them for highly-selective university admission in the United States and abroad.

Qualified Amerigo Honors Track students who are admitted to and choose to attend a Top 30 U.S. University or a Top 10 Liberal Arts College will receive a scholarship worth up to \$15,000 towards their first year of tuition.\*

• ELIGIBILITY: Qualified International students (additional fees apply)

\* To receive the Amerigo Honors Track Scholarship, students must first be invited to participate in the Honors Track program. Once invited, students must remain eligible for the Honors Track by participating fully. Students must attend all Honors Track meetings, submit assigned work on time, remain academically eligible, and not violate the Amerigo Honors Track Honor Code to remain qualified for the scholarship.

# University Advising

## Individualized Parent Consultations

The University Advantage and Honors Track programs offer outreach and engagement with students and their parents regarding their child's university application planning and progress. Parent Advising sessions can be arranged individually, and all parents are encouraged to register for and attend the variety of university planning seminars hosted annually.

## Global Scholars Program

Top-performing students can apply to the Amerigo Global Scholars Program, which recognizes students with outstanding grades and involvement in extracurricular activities. Global Scholars are eligible for participation in prestigious summer academic programs, with past programs at University of Chicago and Stanford University.

## Standard University Advising

For international homestay students who do not enroll in the University Advantage program are welcome to take part in the standard university counseling services available to all Saint John's students.

Our partner Amerigo also offers these students the University Advantage Online program. This program provides students with a self-paced, online university preparation course designed to educate students on the requirements of admission in the United States, Canada, and U.K. This online curriculum gives age-level and grade-level appropriate counseling & guidance on the student's path to university admission.

In addition to this online, self-paced college planning curriculum, students and parents in Amerigo's homestay program are invited to attend the variety of college planning webinars hosted annually by our team of university admission professionals.

# Academic Advising Program

A vital component to American university preparation is ensuring that students make the most out of the coursework offered at school. Through the following academic advising programs, our International Department works to keep international students on track to meet graduation requirements, and aims to incorporate their academic goals and interests into the planning process.

## Pre-Arrival Course Planning

Our academic advising team sets up course schedule planning meetings with each new international student before they arrive on campus.

These meetings are opportunities to discuss the US high school curriculum and address the common misconceptions that international students have about US high school course selection (such as graduation requirements, pre-requisites to take AP and honors courses, and how course planning and scheduling works at our school).

These meetings are also an opportunity, where possible, for our team to create a tentative course schedule for each international student to give them a vision of what kind of courses they will take in their first year.

## Advanced Coursework & Yearly Academic Planning

The ability to meet graduation requirements and to achieve a student's academic goals depends entirely on proper academic planning. As a result, our academic advisors meet with both new and returning students annually to address their goals and to create a custom academic plan for the year ahead.

## Parent Consultations

Saint John's International Department understands that on occasion, our international students' parents would like a consultation with staff to address their student's academic goals and needs.

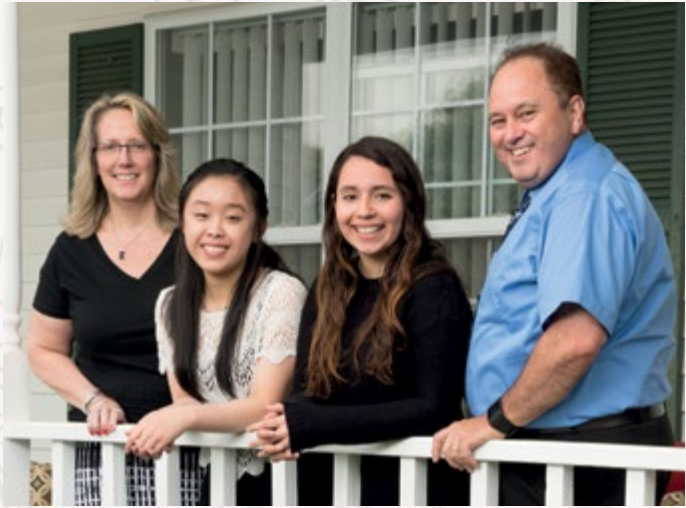
