- In 6th grade, students begin developing the ability to solve basic computer science problems.
- A diverse array of courses, ranging from Intro to Swift Programming to both Advanced Placement (AP) computer science courses, are provided.
- Featured courses include Computer Aided Design and 3D Printing, Introduction to Algorithmic Thinking and Computational Technologies and Introduction to Cybersecurity.
