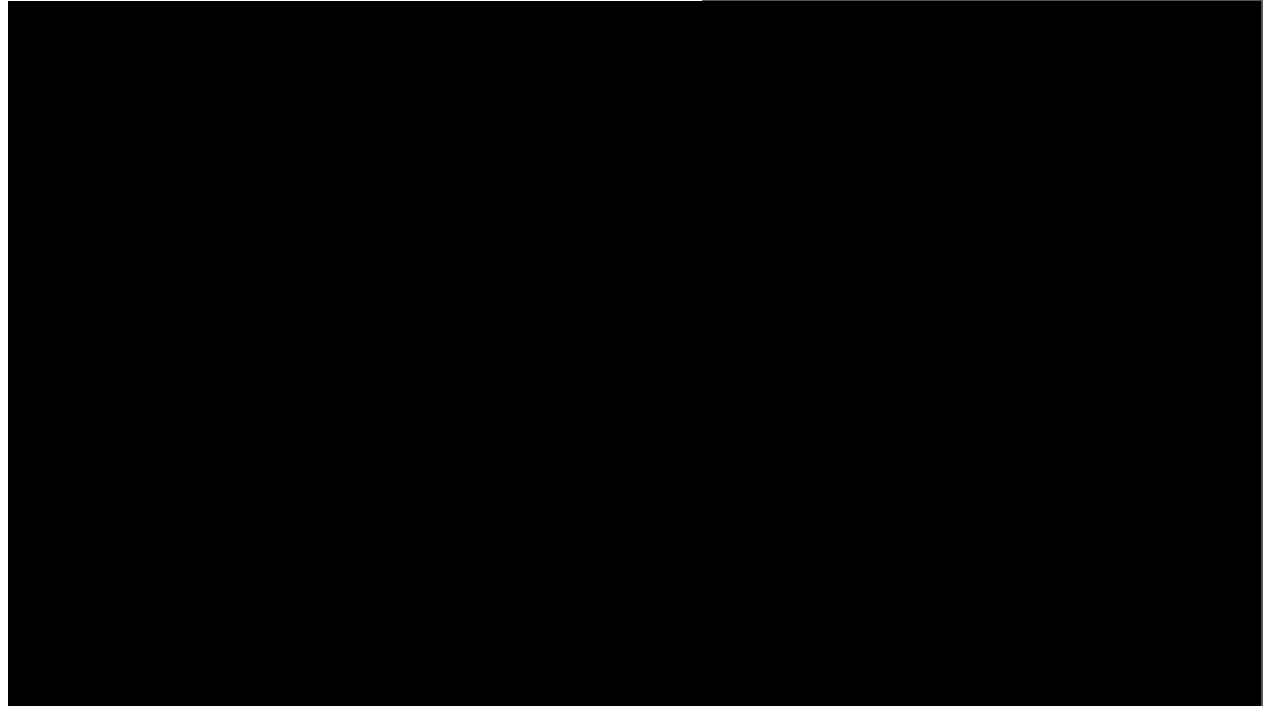

■ Anatomage Table

Only 40 high schools in the US offer students an Anatomage Table, which is used for anatomy visualization and digital dissection.

The Innovation Center is an advanced STEM lab where students take part in hands-on learning.



Advanced Business Program

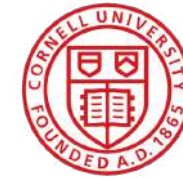

At Saint Anthony's, international students who choose to live in Homestay not only get a great education, they also find loving homes and create lasting relationships with their host families.



Safety is always the #1 priority for our students. All host families undergo a rigorous application and screening process to ensure they are a good candidate to host.

THIS INCLUDES:

- A comprehensive application
- Background check for every adult in the home
- An interview
- An in-person home check by an international staff team member
- Matching to student interest forms to ensure a good fit for both student and host (completed after acceptance into program)

HOMESTAY

- Students live in safe, comfortable homestays in close proximity to the school
- Students have comfortable bedrooms, including a dresser, bed, desk and closet
- Host families and students are paired through a methodical matching process
- Regular acculturation activities are offered through both the host family and the school
- Our international team is in constant communication with families, including receiving monthly reports
- 24/7 team is available for emergency assistance or urgent issues
- The host family offers a full-time English language environment
- Hosts provide transportation to and from the school every day
- Family provides healthy meals every day
