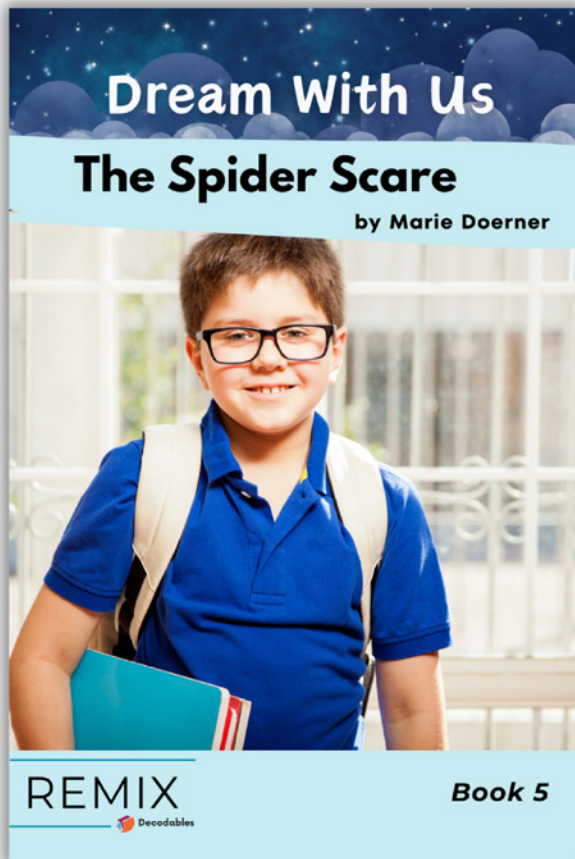
Learn about how anime became so popular... and even get some ideas of new anime to watch in this fact-filled decodable companion.

Emily is afraid to speak up for what's right... until a special friend named Annie helps her find her voice. In this decodable book, readers will spend time practicing reading words with open syllables.

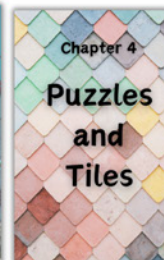
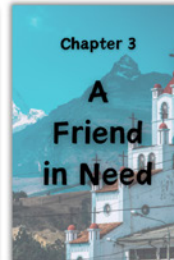

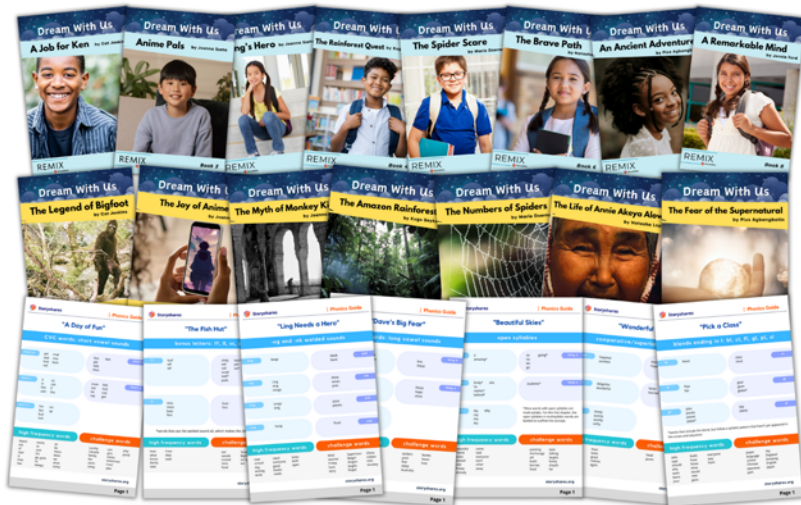
A REMARKABLE MIND
