PURPA Standard 20 — Demand Response Practices
 16 U.S.C § 2621(d)(20)

 PURPA Standard 21 — Electric Vehicle Charging Programs

16 U.S.C § 2621(d)(20)



A. In general. Each electric utility shall promote the use of demand-response and demand flexibility practices by commercial, residential, and industrial consumers to reduce electricity consumption during periods of unusually high demand.



#### Analysis:

- Existing Demand Rates for Large Commercial, Industrial,
  Agricultural as well as Time of Use Rates for members.
- Currently no <u>rate</u> incentive to offer additional Demand Response Programs

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to monitor our system and investigate future programs for consideration if they can show a positive return on investment for the membership.



#### B. Rate Recovery

ii. Nonregulated Electric Utilities—A nonregulated electric utility may establish rate mechanisms for the timely recovery of the costs of promoting demand-response and demand flexibility practices in accordance with subparagraph (A).



#### Analysis:

- Existing Rate Structures
- Cost of Service Study

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to evaluate rate structures based on Cost of Service Studies and any other available information.



- Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
  - A. Promote affordable and equitable electric vehicle charging options for residential, commercial, and public electric vehicle charging infrastructure;
  - B. Improve the customer experience associated with electric vehicle charging, including by reducing charging times for light, medium-, and heavy-duty vehicles;
  - C. Accelerate third party investment in electric vehicle charging for light-, medium-, and heavy-duty vehicles; and
  - D. Appropriately recover the marginal costs of delivering electricity to electric vehicles and electric vehicle charging infrastructure.



- Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
  - A. Promote affordable and equitable electric vehicle charging options for residential, commercial, and public electric vehicle charging infrastructure;



#### Analysis:

- DMEA owned chargers
- EV Charger Rate for Level III equipment

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to evaluate other options for additional promotion if they show sufficient benefit to the membership.



- i. Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
  - B. Improve the customer experience associated with electric vehicle charging, including by reducing charging times for light-, medium-, and heavy-duty vehicles;



#### Analysis:

DMEA owned charger partnership with ChargePoint

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to evaluate and improve the customer experience as financially prudent.



- i. Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
  - C. Accelerate third party investment in electric vehicle charging for light-, medium-, and heavy-duty vehicles; and



#### Analysis:

- Level III charger rate
- Engineering review and coordination on locations for new charging equipment

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to support third-party investment with nonmonetary incentives.



- i. Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
  - D. Appropriately recover the marginal costs of delivering electricity to electric vehicles and electric vehicle charging infrastructure.



#### Analysis:

Cost of Service Study

#### Staff Recommendation: Adopt

 Continue to evaluate DMEA rates against best available data and Cost of Service Studies.



 Each state shall consider measures to promote greater electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates that—
