COVID Vaccine Available for 6 months & Older at Tséhootsooí Medical Center Pediatric Clinic Starting July 6, 2022. Schedule Your Appointment TODAY.

FORT DEFIANCE, AZ – On June 17, 2022, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration authorized emergency use of Moderna & Pfizer-BioNTech COVID 19 Vaccine to include children down to 6 months of age.

Beginning Wednesday, July 6, 2022, Tséhootsooí Medical Center Pediatric Clinic will provide Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines to children 6 months and older.

COVID-19 vaccines will continue to be available on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. by APPOINTMENT ONLY.

To schedule an appointment, call 928-729-8710 or 8718.

COVID-19 vaccines will also be available at regular scheduled “Well-Child” appointments.

Each individual will be required to wear a face mask & receive a brief health screening upon entering any Fort Defiance Indian Hospital Board facility.
