

Numarics ranks among the top 10 FinTech startups in Switzerland and is among the finalists at the Swiss FinTech Awards 2023

Baar, May 2, 2023: Numarics was named one of the Top 10 Startups of the Swiss FinTech Awards 2023 as well as one of the Top 5 Early Stage FinTech Startups and is thus one of the finalists for the coveted award. The first award for the artificial intelligence-based fiduciary solution for Swiss SMEs, the Best Of Swiss Apps Award 2021 in the Enterprise category, was given to the startup just one month after its launch.

As part of the program leading up to the award ceremony for the coveted Swiss FinTech Award, the two founders Dominique Rey and Kristian Kabashi, will attend the Boot Camp at Accenture in Zurich on May 3, 2023. Together with the nomination announcement, Numarics announces version 2.0 of the mobile app.

Already their first award confirmed the innovative positioning of the startup Numarics. After one and a half years of development, the launch of the solution for SMEs in Switzerland was scheduled for September 2021. Then in October 2021, quite surprisingly, came the gold award of the Best of Swiss Apps award for their mobile solution. "This award was the result of hard work and consistent implementation of our vision, which we have believed in since Numarics was founded. A few months later, our main investors came in," recalls Rey.

On May 24, 2023, the founders will pitch to the jury and supporters of the award. "The Swiss FinTech Award is the highest honor for us and the hallmark of the step from startup to established FinTech company," says Kabashi.

On June 13, the Finanz und Wirtschaft Forum will host the leading Swiss fintech conference "<u>FinTech 2023</u>" and the Swiss FinTech Awards Night will then take place.

Numarics is accounting in the fast lane. With an AI-powered accounting system developed by fiduciaries, auditors and technology process automation experts, and founded as a fintech company, it has focused on increasing efficiency in the fiduciary sector through the optimized interaction of fiduciary experts and digital ecosystem.

Milestones include a partnership with the major bank UBS and the acquisition of the top accounting firm A&O Kreston. The Numarics leadership team has thus expanded to include



Emre Özdemir, certified public accountant, and Benjamin Merkli, certified tax and fiduciary expert, among others. In 2023 Numarics employs over 150 people, divided into fiduciary and digital experts. Over 100 fiduciary experts work for Swiss entrepreneurs at nine locations in Switzerland.
