Planned Employee Development.

Employees are encouraged to take charge of their development by having an annual individual development discussion with their manager. Once individual learning needs are agreed, the manager meets with L&D to confirm the functional learning needs that are incorporated into the Company needs analysis. Once checked for alignment to the business strategy and the availably of budget, the annual company development plan is approved. Both individual and company learning initiatives are then implemented.

Study Assistance.

Belgotex provides opportunities for employees to receive a bursary to further their formal education. During the personal development discussion employees have with their managers, employees are encouraged to raise any personal study goals that they would like to undertake in their own time. Or the employee can approach L&D directly. All study assistance applications that met the study assistance requirements are handled by the Bursary committee.

Production Development Pathways.

To offer employees the opportunity to develop their careers and to upgrade their existing skills the production career development pathway was introduced. The pathway opens the door for an employee to qualify for a tertiary qualification. Both the Carpet Technology (level 1 to 3) and the CTF Learnership form the gateway qualifications. From there an employee can progress through the Production Technology qualification (NQF level 2 to 4) progressing to Supervisory Development Programmes (NQF Levels 3 to 5) and thereafter to Management Development

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Working At Belgotex.

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Belgotex In-Service Program.

Students studying towards the National Diploma in Textile Technology, Carpet Design, Carpet Technology or Quality have applied for and been a part of the development practices at Belgotex. 6 or 12-month contracts with a stipend ensure the students are exposed to the areas required for their Diploma programs to be signed off. Many employees have been offered permanent positions after completing their in-service training and attained their qualification.



Belgotex Apprenticeship Program.

Belgotex has a rich history of upskilling both existing employees and or unemployed people through formal apprenticeship programs. Recently Fitter, Electrician, Instrumentation, Winding & Twisting, Needlepunch and Tufting Mechanician apprenticeship programs have been sponsored Annually as part of the company talent review process future skills requirements are determined and apprenticeship numbers are approved to meet future skills requirements.

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Belgotex Graduate Program.

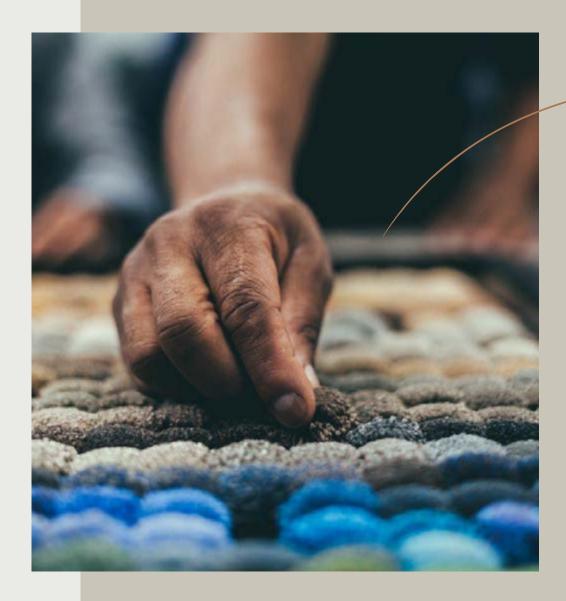

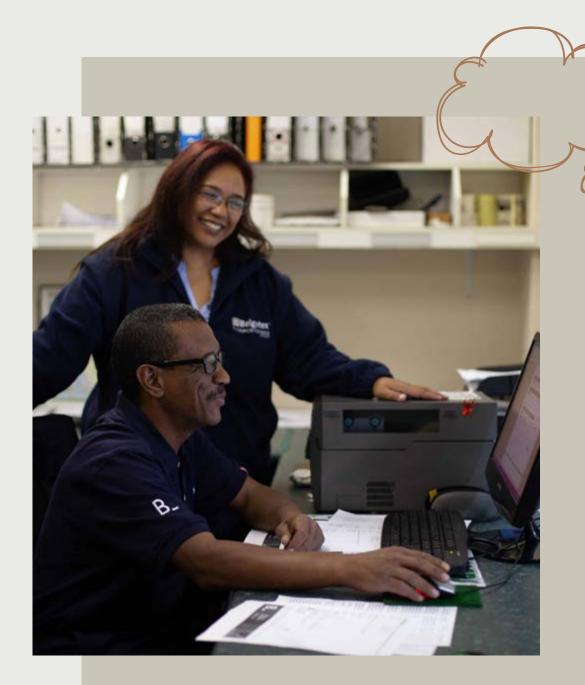

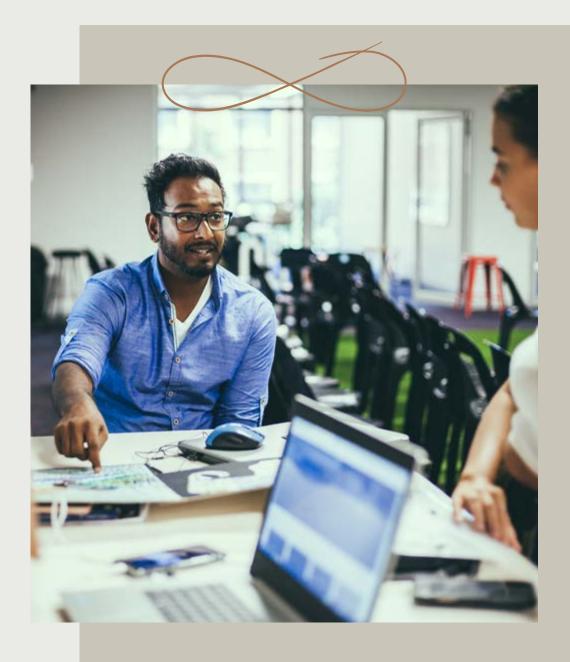
