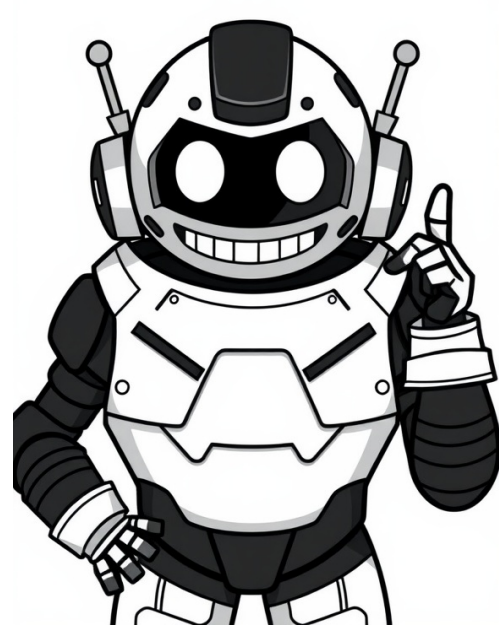

The new display is the most significant change, featuring a massive 2.4" color screen with multiple themes and colors to choose from. Durability The Aegis X has the same IP67 rating as previous models, meaning it's waterproof, dust-proof, and shockproof. However, the huge display raises concerns about its ability to withstand shocks. The screen's plastic cover doesn't look sturdy enough, but this mod is not made for heavy use. It can handle abuse better than regular gadgets, but it's not indestructible. The home screen displays a variety of customization options, including Auto function toggling, theme changes, and screen color adjustments. However, accessing these features can be somewhat confusing, especially for seasoned users. The Aegis X has a concealed micro-USB port next to the 510 connection, but using an external charger is recommended most of the time, and leaving the on-board charging for emergencies only. In terms of performance, the mod fires instantly, has accurate resistance readings, and protects against short-circuits and reverse battery polarity. The included Cerberus tank has been around for a while, so it's a tried-and-true sub-ohm atomizer, but it doesn't really stand out in any way. The tank features top filling, adjustable airflow, and comes with two GeekVape Super Mesh X1 coil-heads rated at 0.2Ω resistance. The Aegis X is not perfect, but it's one of the nicer mods I own, for sure. It has a gorgeous, customizable display, which makes it worth considering if you have an older Aegis mod. In this reviewer's experience, vaping at 75 watts yielded a full day's usage without needing to recharge. The device can be charged via the Micro USB port using a 5V/2A charge. Coil Performance ----- The X1 Mesh Coil recommends vaping between 60-80w and performs well at 75w with airflow halfway open, yielding a slightly warm vape. However, flavor is lacking compared to other coils like the X2. It's worth noting that the X1 coil requires around 4 tanks (22ml of e-liquid) to break in fully. Safety Precautions ----- When charging the device, it's essential to remove batteries and use an external charger to avoid potential risks. Leaving the device to charge overnight or on a flammable surface is not recommended. By following these guidelines and leveraging the Aegis X's features, users can enjoy a premium vaping experience while maintaining safety and optimal battery performance.
