This is the full form of the character for "crown." It shows the crown's line of descent from the beginning, each adding his/her thumbprint.

帝 dì sovereign

stand up + crown + towel

The father is the reigning sovereign. You've heard of the story: "The Sovereign's New Clothes"? The sovereign stands up in front of his subjects wearing only a crown and towel.

The oldest son is the crown prince, the next human in line for the crown.

军 jūn army, *chariot

一+车

crown + vehicle

Prince #2 is put in charge of the army. His symbol is the crowned chariot.

crown + offer/slingshot

Prince #3 is meant to be a scholar but is always into mischief, trying to distract his father from his writing, with a slingshot.

农 nóng agriculture

crown + scarf

Princess #1 is quite practical, taking on the improvement of the realm's agriculture. Like a 4-H queen, she can be seen wearing a crown and scarf.

top hat + mouth + crown

Princess #2 likes bling, especially her tiara. A tiara is a modified 高; a crown where the front part is taller, alternatively: *亮-几

30 + crown + towel

Princess #3 is a beauty. Here she is the winner of a beauty pageant with a studded (30-jewel) crown and sash, her dress no bigger than a towel.

stand up + crown + compass

Prince #4 is a dreamer. Like Columbus, he stands up to the crown with a compass by his side and declares "the earth is round".

Prince #5 is a royal airhead. He is really quite superfluous.

threads + sovereign

A new tailor is hired by the sovereign, but he gets knotted up in threads during the fitting, and the tailor is fired.

mouth + sovereign

The sovereign is weeping aloud for the loss of his wife.

蹄 tí hoof

lower leg + sovereign

The sovereign is always on a horse, so its hooves are really just an extension of his lower legs.

If you picture this royal family on a family tree, the sovereign is the stem, and the children are the flowering branches.
