- Ambassador Elite:** the top published status tier, requiring 100 qualifying nights and \$23,000 in qualifying purchases in a calendar year, offers dedicated Ambassador service, complimentary Hertz President's Circle status, and a personalized note from the general manager.

Bonvoy Elite Status Validity: Your elite status is valid until the end of the current calendar year and an additional 14 months beyond that. For instance, if you earned your status in 2025, you'll enjoy benefits through the rest of this year, all of 2026, and the first two months of 2027.

Earning Marriott Bonvoy Points: Hotel Stays: You earn 10 points per dollar spent at most Marriott hotel brands. However, some brands offer lower earning rates: 5 points per dollar at Element, Protea Hotels, Residence Inn, TownPlace Suites, and Homes & Villas; 4 points per dollar at StudioRes properties; and 2.5 points per dollar at Marriott Executive Apartments.

Boost Your Earning Rates: Elite status and hotel promotions can increase your earning rates. Keep in mind that you typically need to book directly with Marriott to earn points for a stay. Credit Card Bonuses and Spending: You can earn Marriott Bonvoy points using co-branded credit cards, which offer bonus points on Marriott purchases. Some cards also provide additional perks like elite status and annual free night awards.

Earning Points Through Events: Event Planners: You earn 2 points per dollar spent, plus applicable elite status bonuses, for any qualifying event held at a Marriott property. Basic members can earn up to 60,000 points per event, while elite members earn more depending on their tier.

Referring Friends: You can refer up to five new members each calendar year and earn 2,000 points per stay for up to five paid stays in the first year, up to a maximum of 10,000 bonus points.

- Dining:** Join Eat Around Town to earn points when dining at participating restaurants. Non-elite members get 4 points per dollar spent, while elite members receive 6 points.

You must be in good standing with Marriott for at least 30 days with qualifying activity or 90 days without qualifying activity. You can transfer points in increments of 1,000, but there's a limit of six transactions per year and two per month. The total annual point cap is 100,000 points from your account.
