Due to the compression process, quality loss occurs when converting from raw camera files like CR2 or NEF. JPGs have low file sizes making them suitable for web posting and sharing. They're ideal for sharing images with services that require this format. JPG's widespread use can be attributed to its compression capabilities, but this comes at a cost. As a "lossy" file format, JPG permanently deletes redundant data during compression, leading to a decrease in image quality with each iteration. While overcompression can result in poor image quality, JPG still delivers decent results when used properly. Its ability to compress images at high rates makes it ideal for web use, such as sending emails or uploading vacation photos. Most image editing programs allow converting to JPG, but Windows 10's built-in Photos app does not. Alternative apps like IrfanView and Preview can be used instead. In these apps, selecting the desired quality level controls compression rate, with higher quality resulting in less compression and larger file sizes. Additionally, some apps offer file size limits. For those using Mac, Preview is a capable image editing program that allows cropping, resizing, and converting files. Its export feature enables selecting JPEG format and adjusting compression levels to balance file size and image quality. To convert an image to JPG format, start by selecting the desired output format and then click on the "Select Your Image" button to choose the image you want to convert. Ensure the image is within the 24.41 MB size limit. Agree to the terms of use and click "Convert This Image." Once converted, click "Download The Image" to save your JPG file. Alternatively, you can use MS Paint by opening the image, clicking on File, and selecting Save As or Export as a JPG file. The JPEG file type is equivalent to JPG, with some programs using different spellings. On a Mac, open Preview, click on File, and select Open to choose your file. Then, click on File again, select Export, and choose JPEG from the format menu. You can also use a web browser extension like "Save image as Type" or online conversion tools such as which allows you to convert files by clicking on the green box, selecting your files, and adjusting optional settings before starting the conversion process. Once converted, you can download your JPG files individually or in a ZIP file, or upload them directly to cloud storage services like Dropbox or Google Drive.
