By virtue of my role as President under the Constitution and laws of the United States, including the International Emergency Economic Powers Act and the National Emergencies Act, I, Donald J. Trump, find that the ability of individuals located outside the country to interfere with or undermine confidence in US elections poses an unusual threat to national security and foreign policy. Although no evidence suggests a foreign power altered election outcomes, they have historically sought to exploit America's open system. The spread of digital devices and internet-based communications has created vulnerabilities, as seen in the 2017 Intelligence Community Assessment. To address this threat, I declare a national emergency. I hereby order: The Director of National Intelligence must conduct an assessment within 45 days after each US election to identify any foreign interference and its methods. This assessment should include information on involved persons and foreign governments that authorized or supported it. The Attorney General and Secretary of Homeland Security, in consultation with other agencies and state/local officials, must deliver a report within 45 days evaluating the extent of foreign interference's impact on election infrastructure, vote tabulation, and result transmission. The report should investigate the impact of cyber activities on a political organization's infrastructure, including unauthorized access to sensitive information. It also needs to identify material issues that the Attorney General and Secretary of Homeland Security cannot evaluate or agree upon. The document should include updates and recommendations for remedial actions. Relevant agencies must share information with the Director of National Intelligence. If new information emerges, the report will be amended accordingly. Heads of agencies can provide analysis to the President at any time. The order deals with any foreign person who has directly or indirectly engaged in activities related to foreign interference in a US election. This includes individuals and organizations that have sponsored, concealed, or assisted in such activities. The order also applies to those who own or control entities whose interests are blocked by the government. Imposition of economic and national security sanctions targeting US allies' interests. Sanctions are tailored to specific foreign interference cases, allowing for various measures such as blocking financial transactions, export restrictions, loan prohibitions, foreign exchange limitations, and more. 1. Blocking all property and interest transactions under US jurisdiction. 2. Export license restrictions for goods or services requiring US government approval. 3. Prohibiting US financial institutions from lending to targeted individuals. 4. Restricting foreign currency transactions involving the individual. 5. Prohibiting credit transfers between financial institutions for the benefit of the individual. 6. Barring US persons from investing in or purchasing equity/debt of the individual. 7. Excluding alien corporate officers from the US. 8. Imposing sanctions on principal executive officers of alien-owned companies. 9. Making donations to sanctioned individuals would hinder addressing national emergencies, thus prohibited. 10. Prohibiting contributions and provision of funds, goods, or services to or by sanctioned individuals, as well as receiving such from them. 11. Suspending entry into the US for immigrants and nonimmigrants whose property is blocked due to potential harm to US interests. 12. Prohibiting transactions that evade sanctions, conspire against sanctions, or cause a violation of prohibitions. 13. Defining "person" as an individual or entity, including partnerships, corporations, trusts, and more. 14. "United States person" refers to a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or any entity established under U.S. law in the United States or its territories, as well as foreign nationals present in the country. (d) "Election infrastructure" encompasses information and communication systems used by federal, state, or local governments to manage elections, including voter registration databases, voting machines, and secure transmission equipment; (e) A "United States election" is any federal office election held on or after the order's effective date; (f) "Foreign interference" involves covert, fraudulent, deceptive, or unlawful actions by a foreign government or its agents aimed at influencing or altering an election's outcome or public confidence in election processes; (g) A "foreign government" includes any national authority, political party, or official from a country other than the United States; (h) "Covert" refers to actions taken with the intention of avoiding public acknowledgment of foreign involvement; (i) The term "State" encompasses U.S. states and their territories. 15. The Secretary of the Treasury is authorized to submit recurring and final reports to Congress on the national emergency declared in this order, consistent with section 401(c) of the NEA (50 U.S.C. 1641(c)) and section 204(c) of IEEPA (50 U.S.C. 1703(c)). 16. This order shall be implemented consistent with 50 U.S.C. 1702(b)(1) and (3). 17. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect: (i) the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or (ii) the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals. 18. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations. 19. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the United States, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, employees, or agents, or any other person. This order is hereby issued under the authority of the President of the United States. Given article text here The IRGC's influence operations have been ongoing since 2023, aiming to incite social-political tensions in the US electorate ahead of the 2024 elections. The Cognitive Design Production Center (CDPC), a subsidiary of the IRGC, has been designated by OFAC for its ties to the organization. Moscow employs various tactics, including covert foreign influence campaigns and cyber activities, to undermine US national security and interests globally. The Kremlin uses intelligence services, government-directed proxies, and covert tools to hide its involvement in these efforts. The US has taken action against Russia's global malign influence campaigns, including disrupting outlets controlled by Russian intelligence services. However, the Moscow-based Center for Geopolitical Expertise (CGE) continues to use artificial intelligence tools to interfere in the 2024 US election. CGE personnel work with a GRU unit to carry out sabotage, political interference operations, and cyberwarfare targeting the West. The GRU provided financial support to CGE, allowing it to build and maintain an AI-support server and distribute disinformation across a network of websites imitating legitimate news outlets. Korovin and CGE's operations have been linked to disinformation campaigns in the US election, with Korovin coordinating financial support and CGE using generative AI to spread false information. The OFAC has designated both individuals and entities for their involvement in foreign malign influence in the 2024 US election, as well as their ties to Russian intelligence agencies. This designation imposes significant sanctions on those involved, including a freeze on assets within the US or under US control, and prohibits US persons from engaging in transactions with them. The SDN List comprises names consistent with the law. Sanctions aim not to punish, but to induce beneficial changes in behavior.
