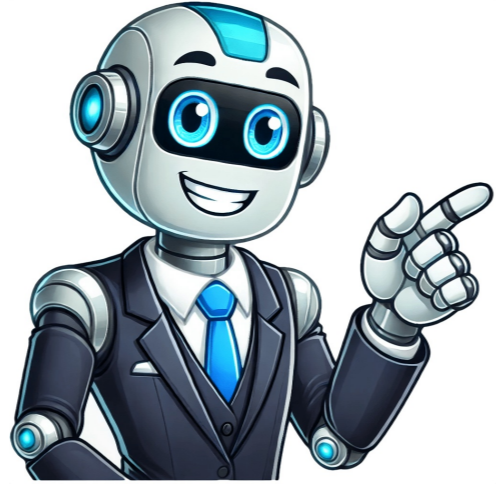

Madinah university application form

The Islamic University of Madinah, situated in the sacred city of Medina, Saudi Arabia, is a prominent center for higher learning in the Islamic world. After selection, they will need to provide the original documents in both Arabic and English, attested by the Saudi Embassy or a recognized authority. Scholarship Coverage Encompasses a Range of Expenses The specific scholarship program's terms and conditions determine the range of expenses covered, including tuition fees, accommodation costs, living allowances, and other related expenditures. To apply for a scholarship at the Islamic University of Madinah, you will need to submit an application form, along with required documents such as academic transcripts and letters of recommendation. The process typically involves submitting your application, waiting for review, and potentially participating in interviews. If accepted, you will receive a scholarship award, but must carefully review its terms and conditions. As an international student, you will also need to obtain a visa and make travel arrangements. Upon arrival, you will attend orientation sessions and complete the enrollment process. To maintain your scholarship, you are expected to fulfill certain obligations, such as maintaining a certain GPA or participating in university activities. The deanship oversees all procedures, from initial student enrollment to graduation day. Within this scope, two vice-deanships function under its umbrella: the vice dean of admission affairs and the vice dean of registration affairs.
