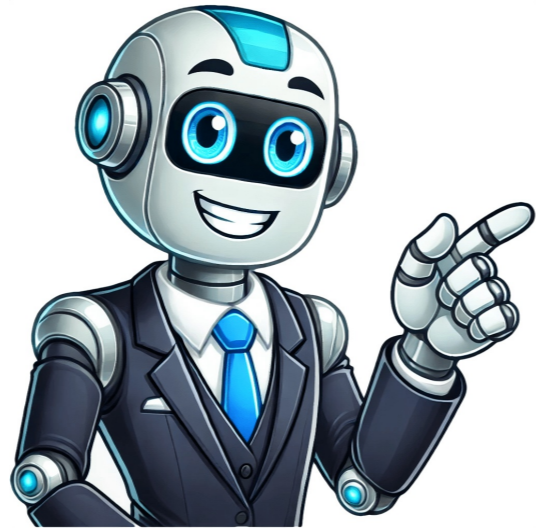

Although Dead by Daylight isn't technically a zombie game, it can be played for a casual and thrilling experience with simple yet hard-to-master mechanics. Players can even play as the killer all the time and Nemesis, making each game a zombie experience. The Sniper Elite series offers co-op zombie games like Nazi Zombie Army, which could have been a DLC or feature in future Sniper Elite games but was released as a standalone expansion. This game features up to 4 players in co-op mode, where you'll go through the campaign and experience the story while tearing through zombies. The unique sniping mechanics from the series are mirrored in this game with bone-shattering kills against zombies. The Typing of the Dead: Overkill puts players in an automated simulation where they must type out words or phrases to defeat attacking zombies, adding a comedic twist to on-rails shooters. This game can be played in two-player co-op and features hilarious randomized kill words. Dead Island offers a zombie apocalypse experience on a paradise island with up to 3 other players in co-op mode, allowing you to choose from 4 different characters each with unique skill trees. Arizona Sunshine is an exclusive VR game set in a post-apocalyptic southwestern America where you can play the campaign with three other players. Although it's too short, the game offers a polished zombie VR experience with an incredible twist at the end. Call of Duty: Zombies "de-make" is powered by enhanced forks of the Quake engine and features automatic deployment on itch.io and GitHub. This project has been in development since 2009 and hosts various builds for players to access. Nazi Zombies: Portable is a Call of Duty: World at War remake, utilizing various enhanced forks of the Quake engine in development since 2009.
