Open sud de france 2025

The 2025 Open Occitanie tennis tournament has confirmed its draw, which begins today in Montpellier. This event, formerly known as Open Sud de France, takes place from January 27 to February 2 and is the only ATP tournament in the week following the Australian Open. Played on indoor hard courts, it typically occurs in early February and serves as a significant stop on the European indoor tennis circuit. Top-seeded Andrey Rublev will face Christopher Eubanks or a qualifier in his first match, while Felix Auger-Aliassime takes on either Stan Wawrinka or Arthur Cazaux. Former champion Alexander Bublik is also present and will defend his title against Gregoire Barrere or Dominik Koepfer. The tournament features several high-profile players, including David Goffin, Flavio Cobolli, and Tallon Griekspoor, who form a predominantly European field with mid-range rankings on the ATP list. The 2025 season is well underway by the time the Open Occitanie commences, with the event scheduled to run from January 27 to February 2, 2025. The semi-finalist will earn €31,090 (\$32,656), and the quarter-finalist will receive €18,015 (\$18,922). The doubles prize money is also on the rise. In 2025, the winner will receive €31,530 (\$33,118), while the runner-up will earn €16,940 (\$17,793).
