Admission to Sixth Form will be based on both academic and non-academic criteria. Students will be assessed in the following areas: Performance in the CSEC Leadership qualities Attendance to school and classes Punctuality to school and classes Involvement in co-curricular activities Conduct/deportment (the number of truancies, demerits and suspensions) will be taken into consideration Compliance with the guidelines set by teachers with regards to the SBA Fulfilling community service obligations. Compliance in payment of required fee This assessment will be used to determine if the student matriculates to the Sixth Form level. Academic Assessment To be considered for admission to Grade 12, applicants must pass at least 6 subjects at the CSEC General Proficiency Level or GCE Ordinary Level Examinations or a combination of the two. At the CSEC level, students must obtain at least 4 subjects with grade 1. At the GCE, O' level, students must obtain at least 4, As. Students short-listed will then be interviewed before the final decision is made. Students who do not perform at the required standard will be asked to leave at the end of Grade Twelve (12). Students entering Ardenne at the Sixth Form level will be asked to furnish all necessary documents for registration. This will include recommendations from the last school attended. The Administration reserves the right not to accept any student whose conduct is not of the standard accepted at Ardenne. ===== Ardenne High School Leadership ===== Winston Roberts, principal from 1996, was succeeded by Esther Tyson in 2000 after serving as vice principal. Erma Hutton acted as principal between May and December 1999 due to illness. She was followed by Esther Tyson until September 2011. Reverend Claude Ellis served as acting principal before Nadine Molloy took over in 2012. Since January 2024, Jacqueline Pinto has been acting principal. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Ardenne transitioned to online teaching due to invested technology and staff capacity building. The school's BYOD policy required students to own a Chromebook for teaching purposes. Despite limited in-person classes, the school received strong support from alumni and stakeholders. Dr. Marcia Keisz was the first female president of York College and won several awards. The school offers various academic programs with an emphasis on innovation. An Academic Award for Excellence is presented to Grade Eleven students with high averages in Mock Examinations. Students are awarded merits for good performance in units tests, examinations, research, practical work, and conduct. ===== Students who wish to attend Ardenne High School in Grade 10 will need to undergo a series of assessments and examinations, including CXC-CSECs, which must be passed by the end of Grade 11. Those students who fail to meet this requirement will only receive a school leaving certificate and are not eligible for any special awards. The admission process is based on both academic and non-academic criteria, with students being evaluated in areas such as leadership qualities, attendance, punctuality, and involvement in extracurricular activities. The number of truancies, demerits, and suspensions will also be taken into account when assessing a student's conduct. To be considered for Grade 12 admission, applicants must have passed at least six subjects at the CSEC General Proficiency Level or GCE Ordinary Level Examinations, or a combination of both. At the CSEC level, students must achieve at least four grades 1 in four subjects, while GCE O Level students must achieve at least four A's. It is also necessary to obtain a grade 1 or 2 in the subject being pursued in Grade 12, as well as a grade 1 or 2 in English Language and Mathematics. The prerequisites for subject selections vary depending on the course chosen. Application forms must be completed online and submitted along with an application fee of \$4,000.00 to the "Necessities" book shop at Ardenne High School. Students' files will be reviewed for non-academic aspects, while academic assessment will be conducted once CSEC results are published. Successful applicants will receive notification via email, and those who meet all requirements will have their names posted on the notice board. Digital Media and Animation and Gaming Design fees total \$10,350 (includes both subjects). Science Lab Fees: \$3,450 for the first science subject; additional sciences cost \$1,380 each thereafter. Payment of these fees is mandatory before attending classes. All Grade Eleven students are invited to attend the Valedictory and Prizegiving Service on July 1st at 5:00 pm. Dress code includes academic gown and mortarboard. Criteria for student participation: - Complete CXC/CSEC programme in at least 8 subjects from grade 10. - Register for at least 8 subjects assigned from grade 10. - Satisfactory completion of School Based Assessment (SBA). - Completion of Community Service with 15 hours per year, minimum five visits. - Active involvement in one co-curricular activity. - No suspensions or disciplinary record in Grades 10 and 11. Valedictorian criteria: - Peers vote for the Valedictorian; Academic Staff make the final decision. - Outstanding academic performance, completion of Community Service, exemplary behaviour (no suspensions), and submission of all SBA's required. Ardenne High School recently had a notable event when two brothers received an opportunity to travel to Cuba for medical studies. The school has also won several awards, including the JCDC Marcus Garvey Awards for Excellence in Performing Arts, which it has held for over a decade. Nadine Molloy, Ardenne High School Principal, Receives Prime Minister's Medal of Appreciation ===== Molloy has been recognised for her years of service in the field of education. She hailed from the parish of Portland and was a trained teacher and librarian who served in various capacities across education. She also served as President of the Jamaica Association of Principals of Secondary Schools (JAPSS) for two terms. Molloy recently stated that the arts need to be more widely accepted, especially for girls and women in the region to be more progressive. Molloy incorporated Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) into her approach. Clive Blackwood, a Federal Reserve Bank of New York auditor, urged sixth-formers at Ardenne High School to make the most of opportunities in Jamaica as they grow into adulthood.
