Paris roubaix 2025 dates

Paris-Roubaix, often referred to as "l'enfer du Nord", is the most challenging and grueling classic in the cycling calendar. Its extreme physical and technical demands make it a true test of endurance for even the most skilled cyclists. Some riders are intimidated by its harsh conditions, but many others see it as the pinnacle of their season.The Paris-Roubaix Femmes and Paris-Roubaix events are coming up on April 12th and 13th in France, marking the end of the spring classics. These races are known for their unpredictable weather and treacherous pav roads, making them a true spectacle for fans. The Paris-Roubaix is one of the three monuments of the cycling calendar, along with Milan-San Remo and Tour des Flandres.The Paris-Roubaix has become an iconic event in the world of cycling, known for its unpredictable weather, treacherous roads, and the unwavering dedication of its riders. The combination of these factors creates an electric atmosphere that is unmatched by any other race.Throughout its 122-year history, the Paris-Roubaix has crowned numerous legends on both the men's and women's sides, with Roger De Vlaeminck and Tom Boonen holding the record for most wins with four titles each. The course has passed through 13 different cities over the years, with Compigne being the longest-running host since 1977.Despite its rich history, the Paris-Roubaix remains a fiercely contested event, with no single country dominating its palmares. The Belgians lead the way with 57 victories, while the French trail behind with 28 wins. As the 2025 edition approaches, fans and riders alike are eagerly anticipating what promises to be another unforgettable experience.Le Paris-Roubaix Femmes avec Zwift revient pour sa cinquieme dition en 2025, tandis que la course masculine affiche son itinraire de 259.2 km. La compilation feminine aura lieu le 12 avril, tout comme l'anne demire, et se droulera sur 146.5 kilometres avec 17 secteurs pavés.Le Paris-Roubaix, une course cycliste emblmatique qui a t dominé par les coureurs les plus dous et les premires chappes au cours des annes prcdentes. Cependant, le secteur 5, Camphin-en-Pvle, ainsi que le Carrefour de l'Arbre du secteur 4, pourraient bien tre les derniers vritables opportunités d'attaque avec leurs valuations respectives de quatre et cinq toiles. Les trois derniers secteurs pavés sont relativement courts mais la difficult du dernier avant-dernier secteur Willems Hem, situ 8.2 km de la ligne d'arrive, pourrait encore rserver une surprise. Le dernier sprint prs de l'emblmatique viodrome de Roubaix dcidera nouveau du vainqueur.Mathieu van der Poel a domin en 2024 et conserv son titre aprs une chappe en solo sur son Aeroad Canyon 60 km de la ligne d'arrive, ce qui le place comme un des favoris pour cette anne. Van der Poel sera de nouveau sur la ligne de dpart avec l'appui inconditionnel de ses coéquipiers, mais s'il ne parvient pas maintenir sa distance, Alpecin-Deceuninck a un remplaant dans Jasper Philipsen qui a termin deuxime en 2023 et 2024. Le sprint final du Belge fait de lui un autre favori.Le champion du monde actuel, Tadej Pogaar, n'a pas exclu la participation la course pour la premire fois, ce qui pourrait amener un duel pique entre van der Poel et Pogaar. Gagner un troisieme titre d'affile placera van der Poel au mme niveau que les deux seuls autres coureurs de l'histoire ayant russi cet exploit : Francesco Moser et Octave Lapize.Pour la course fminine, la liste des favoris est ouverte entre CANYON//SRAM zondacrypto, Movistar, et Fenix-Deceuninckall qui devraient amener des quipes de haut vol. La liste de dpart de la course feminine reste confirmer, mais CANYON//SRAM zondacrypto est susceptible de compter sur Zoe Beckstedt et Chlo Dygert. Les cyclistes comme Marlen Reusser (Movistar), Puck Pieterse (Fenix-Deceuninck), ainsi que Cat Ferguson, sont galement des prtendantes la victoire. L'vnement sera diffus sur plusieurs chanes internationales et plateformes de streaming en 2025.The Paris-Roubaix 2025 cycling race took place on April 13, 2025. The final general classification saw Mathieu van der Poel (Alpecin-Deceuninck) take the top spot with a time of 5 hours and 31 minutes and 27 seconds. He was closely followed by Tadej Pogaar (UAE Team Emirates XRG), who trailed behind by just over one minute. The top 10 finishers were:1. Mathieu van der Poel (Alpecin-Deceuninck)2. Laurenz Rex (Intermarch-Wanty) - +4:36The Paris-Roubaix 2025 route included cobblestone sectors and other challenging terrain, making it a true test of endurance for the riders.Given article text here Tadej Pogaar became the eighth rider to win ParisRoubaix three times,[3] and the third rider to win three times in succession after Octave Lapize in the early 1900s and Francesco Moser in the late 1970s. The race was held on a 259.2 kilometres (161.1 mi) course with 55.3 kilometres of cobblestones spread out over 30 sectors.[4] All eighteen UCI WorldTeams and seven UCI ProTeams participated in the event, including AlpecinDeceuninck ArkaB&B Hotels Cofidis DecathlonAG2R La Mondiale EF EducationEasyPost GroupamaFDJ Ineos Grenadiers IntermarchWanty LidlTrek Movistar Team Red BullBoraHansgrohe SoudalQuick-Step Team Bahrain Victorious Team JaycoAlUla Team Picnic PostNL UAE Team Emirates XRG VismaLease a Bike XDS Astana Team. In March 2025, Tadej Pogaar announced he would take part in ParisRoubaix for the first time.[6] Prior to the race, media considered Mathieu van der Poel as favourite for the win,[9] [10] but Pogaar ultimately won, with decisive attacks by van der Poel and Mads Pedersen.Following the Paris-Roubaix cycling event, an incident occurred where a spectator threw a bottle at Mathieu van der Poel, who was racing and won his third consecutive title in the event. The incident was met with condemnation from various groups, including the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and riders' unions. Both the UCI and Van der Poel's team Alpecin-Deceuninck expressed a desire to see the spectator held accountable for their actions.The winner of the event, Mathieu van der Poel, secured his third win in a row after an intense duel with Tadej Pogaar. However, Pogaar struggled due to a crash and puncture, which ultimately contributed to his loss. The event was marred by concerns over spectator safety and behavior.In the aftermath of the incident, a man handed himself in to police on Monday, following reports that he had been seen at the scene.
