Organized by the City of Barcelona and RPM SPORTS, this event has broken its own record for participation for the second consecutive year.Last year's edition had 28,235 participants, a number that eDreams Mitja Marat Barcelona by Brooks 2025 has surpassed with over 2,000 entries sold. This makes it the half-marathon in Spain with the most runners and one of the top two events in Europe, after only Berlin."We are thrilled to see how runners continue to choose Barcelona as one of their favorite challenges. We believe we have been able to convey that our race goes beyond the 21km run. Therefore, it is runner's responsibility to check his/her email for updates.Athletes must follow instructions and rules regarding health management. The event has two main race distance: 21.097km fully urban which is certified by Federaci Catalana d'Atletisme through IAAF commissaire. Half-marathon follows IAAF road racing regulations and has Gold Label from World Athletics. Judges RFEA and FCA ensure rules compliance.Registration open to all persons with bib, whether federated or not, over 18 age on race day. Minors cannot participate in pushchairs or other transport devices. Organisation reserves right to close registrations when maximum capacity reached for safety guarantee.Race starts at 08:30 hours and ends at 12:15 hours. Official time limit is 2h45:00 from last participant leaving starting line. Blind athletes start according to time marked on registration. Organizers can make additional starts for safety, logistical reasons.Classification times are only those provided by runner in registration form. Organisation has reserved Sub-Elite box for participants requesting it and accrediting following times for men: 30:00 in 10k, 1h05:00 in half-marathon, 2h20:00 in marathon; for women: sub 35:30, 1h15:30, 2h35:00.Note: Sub-Elite athletes must email info@edreamsmitjabarcelona.es with attached documents to qualify.The event features an official registration process that took place within the last year. The starting blocks are allocated based on registration, and participants must accept their assigned start box at the time of registration.Participants can modify their start box before January 12th, 2025, by accessing their registration management. Each box has a distinct color, and only those with the corresponding race bib can access it.The event has a limited quota of 30,000 bibs, available for purchase at two price tiers: 32 for bibs 1-10,000 and 36 for numbers 10,001-30,000. Registration is only valid after payment has been made, and the event will close when all slots are filled or on February 2nd, 2025.Special registration categories exist for people with disabilities: visually impaired and intellectually disabled. Those with visual impairments can register online and select their start box, while intellectual disability participants must also register online and indicate their box preference. Both groups require proof of accreditation to participate in the classification and award ceremonies. Participants who wish to change their information or transfer their bib can do so through the registration platform's Manage your registration section. Transferred bibs allow new participants to take over the original bib holder's responsibilities, but they must accept all the terms and conditions outlined in these regulations.From January 12th, changes to a runner's name are no longer possible. The Organization can make modifications to the exchange methodology without notice. If a transfer or direct sale between participants occurs outside the established process, the original holder's participation may be invalidated and they could be excluded from future events. For safety reasons, transferring a bib to another runner without authorization is prohibited. If this happens before the race, the bib number can be disqualified and the runner cannot participate. This practice will also result in registration being blocked for four years.the Organisation has the right to take actions against anyone who breaks the rules, as stated by the law. If someone commits a mistake or does something wrong, they will face consequences and possibly even go to court. This includes things like not registering for the race, wearing someone else's bib, or using a fake one. The list of bad things is long and might include other things that are not listed here. Whoever breaks the rules will be called an 'offending runner'. They will be identified by the Organisation during the race and removed from the event if they have done something wrong. If someone is discovered to have broken the rules after the race has finished, they can still face consequences.The Organisation wants to make sure everyone follows the rules, so they might not let someone register again in the future. They also want other races to know about people who have been banned for breaking the rules.Failure to collect race bib and bag before closing date may lead to cancellation or waiver. Cancellations due to unforeseen circumstances allow organisation to revise articles 7 & 9.Race bib must be clearly visible, unmanipulated, on torso front throughout event.Chip provided by organisation must be worn, not shared; return on race day mandatory for non-participants.Chip malfunction may incur 5 penalty; only those with provided chip will be ranked.Course controlled by RFEA Judges Committee; public roads secured by Guardia Urbana de Barcelona.Medical services available at start & finish, along course; refreshments offered at km 5, 10, 15, and final station.Registered runners must provide medical info on bib; participants under medical supervision may be withdrawn.Course signposted according to World Athletics standards; organisation reserves right to modify route due to unforeseen circumstances.Participants consent to name publication on website and results pages.The data of registered runners will be transferred to the Royal Spanish Athletics Federation for insurance purposes and ranking management. This information will also be shared with the main collaborator. In accordance with the Data Protection Law, participants can exercise their rights by contacting the federation or UTE RPM EXPERIENTIA. By registering, participants declare that they are aware of and accept these regulations. Runners must be in optimal health to participate, having passed medical checks and being free from any illness or injury that could discourage their participation.The race classification, both in the media and online, will be done without expecting any payment or compensation. Organizers recommend a medical check-up beforehand, with participants accepting the risks associated with the sporting activity. The organization has liability insurance, as well as accident insurance for all participants, following current legislation. Categories for male and female runners are defined by age groups: Under-23, Senior, Master 35, Master 40, Master 45, Master 50, Master 55, Master 60, Master 65, Master 70, Master 75, and Master 80. Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in the overall category, with disabled runners also receiving their own trophies after the race. Unclaimed trophies will remain with the organization after a certain deadline. Prizes for winners may be withheld if they fail a mandatory anti-doping test. Complaints must be made within 30 minutes of results announcement to the Chief Referee, whose decision is final. Registration implies acceptance of these regulations, and organizers reserve the right to make decisions not covered by existing rules.
