There are numerous Christian Motorcycle Clubs (CMCs) in the United States that promote Jesus as their cause and operate on Christian values & principles. One such example is the Disciple Christian MC, founded by James Johnson in 2009. It's a mix of old-school hardcore MC culture centered around Christ and Biblical brotherhood. The club has a mission to disciple men to have daily prayer times and support the 1% world through prayer. The Christian Motorcyclists Association (CMA), established in 1975, is an international non-profit organization that aims to evangelize to the motorcycling community. Other notable Christian motorcycle clubs include Bond Slaves MC, founded in 1989 in Canada, which wears a traditional 3-Piece patch and only rides North American-made bikes. Bikers for Christ (BFC) is another non-denominational international ministry that was established in California in 1990 and has over 2,300 members with chapters worldwide. God's Squad Christian Motorcycle Club (GSCMC), founded in Australia in 1971, is a patch club that primarily ministers among outlaw motorcycle clubs and associated groups. Tribe of Judah Motorcycle Ministries (ToJMM) was founded in 1984 by Ben Priest, senior pastor of River of God Church. The ministry reaches out to the outlaw biker world and people in all walks of life through motorcycle events and rallies. They ride American-made V-twin motorcycles like Harley-Davidsons and wear a 3-piece back-patch similar to traditional outlaw clubs. ToJMM has over 50 chapters across the US, as well as chapters in Europe, Australia, and North America. Honor Bound Motorcycle Ministry (HBMM) was founded in 2006 by Chaplain Russ and Judy Cockrum and is now the national motorcycle ministry of the Assemblies of God. HBMM requires members to take an evangelism course and be drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free before receiving their patch. The local chapter comes under the authority of the local church leadership. Faith Riders Motorcycle Ministry has over 350 churches across 29 states (and two in Cuba). Soldiers for Jesus Motorcycle Club exists to glorify God by teaching God's Holy Word and training faithful disciples. They have chapters across the US and internationally, with their name inspired by 2 Timothy 2:3 from the Bible. The Least of Saints Motorcycle Club is a Christian-based non-profit organization dedicated to reaching out to local communities. They have chapters across the US, including eight in Texas, as well as international chapters in Mexico, Honduras, and New Zealand. Prodigals Redeemed MC was founded in Houston, Texas in 2014. It's a non-denominational motorcycle club that believes in reaching out to people from all walks of life.
